DENTAL BOARD ENFORCEMENT OFFICER INTRODUCTION

Ms. Hockenberry introduced Michael T. Flugge, Enforcement Officer to the Board members. She explained that Mr. Flugge handles investigations in the northwest quadrant of the state. Mike has been employed with the Dental Board since 1985.

ENFORCEMENT UPDATE

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board that there were currently ten (10) cases pending hearings, of which five (5) have been scheduled. A correction needs to be made to the Enforcement Update Report because there is currently one case under appeal. We currently have five (5) cases pending the Hearing Officers Report and Recommendation, of which one (1) will be on the agenda for the March meeting. Currently we have no cases wherein no hearing was requested. Twenty-four (24) licensees are currently under suspension and two (2) cases were referred to the Quality Intervention Program (QUIP) since the last Board meeting so we currently have eight (8) cases pending QUIP. Ms. Hockenberry stated that fifty-one (51) cases have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretary and are recommended to be closed.

Due to the requirement in Chapter 4715.03(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, that "The board shall not dismiss any complaint or terminate any investigation except by a majority vote of its members,..." Ms. Hockenberry reviewed the cases to be closed with the Board.

Ms. Sabat stated that during the previous Board meeting the members had been given a draft copy of a Dental Hygiene Jurisprudence Examination for review. She recognized Ms. Naber for her efforts in developing the questions for the examination.

Ms. Naber stated that the examination was a compilation of thirty (30) questions that would be used in a twenty-five (25) questions test similar to the examination previously approved for the dentists.

Motion by Dr. Murphy, second by Dr. Kyger, to approve the Dental Hygiene Jurisprudence Examination as presented.

Roll call vote.

Motion carried unanimously.

LAW AND RULES REVIEW COMMITTEE REPORT

Dr. Murphy informed the Board due to the Public Rules Hearing earlier in the meeting there was nothing new to report at this time.

SECRETARY'S EXPENSE REPORT

Dr. Hills stated that he had spent in excess of twenty (20) hours per week attending to Board business.

Motion by Ms. Wise, second by Ms. Naber, to approve the Secretary's expense report.

Roll call vote.

Motion carried unanimously.

OFFICE EXPENSE REPORT

The report of the Board expenditures was reviewed.

Motion by Dr. Murphy, second by Dr. Vesoulis, to approve the expense report and approve payment of the January, 2005 Board bills.

Roll call vote.

Motion carried unanimously.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

EXECUTIVE BUDGET FY'S 06-07

Ms. Reitz addressed the issue of the Governor's proposal to consolidate 27 boards and commissions, including the dental board. She stated that she attended a meeting February 4, 2005 and at this meeting, the Governor's Chief of Staff Jon Allison announced that as part of a tight budget that will be recommended for the upcoming biennium, there will be a recommendation to reform boards and commissions. She said he stated that the proposal to reform will inspire heated debate among all interested parties, and he asked for the boards' support in this effort on behalf of the Governor. She stated he said that the plan is to consolidate 27 boards and commissions under either the Department of Health, the Department of Commerce or the Department of Public Safety. He said the boards will not be eliminated, but the goal is to consolidate administrative functions in an effort to cut costs and save money, and to provide management oversight and assistance to boards as needed. She said that Mr. Allison stated that the plan will be introduced next week, and a transition team consisting of representatives of the Governor's Office, the Office of Budget and Management, and the agencies represented above who will be housing the boards, will be established to make

recommendations regarding the consolidation efforts. Mr. Allison also said that they are working with the Office of Budget and Management to quantify the savings that would be realized.

Ms. Reitz reported that this whole situation presents a challenge to the boards who have to testify on the budget next week in presenting the numbers and in answering questions that will inevitably come. She stated that board directors were strategizing, some boards were taking different positions than others. She stated she wanted to be supportive, yet concerns involving the ability to continue to provide efficient services and programs that we have been providing existed. She also stated that she was worried about morale of the staff in the interim, especially without there being many details known about the plan.

Dr. Vesoulis remarked that since we are self sufficient through fees, and that no GRF money is used, not sure how this proposal will save money. Dr. Wright commented that although Ms. Reitz won't say so herself, she and the Dental Board are considered by some agencies as a model of efficiency and that she has been called upon to agency directors needing some advice and direction in the management of their boards. Keeping that in mind, he is very concerned with a proposal that changes the current structure.

Dr. Beckwith asked about whether the Board members could express any concerns that they had with the plan with legislators and/or the Governor's office. Ms. Reitz responded by saying that the Governor's office has asked for our support, and if we planned to oppose the proposal, that the Governor's office asked for a courtesy call.

Other Board members voiced concerns about the consolidation plan, citing the fact that on the national level, dental boards that were under an umbrella structure were not active and were difficult to work with. Mr. Landes suggested that Ms. Reitz cannot advise Board members on taking a position in opposition by proxy. He did state that in his opinion, members of the Board are appointed by the Governor, and therefore should address questions to the Governor before taking any further action on this issue.

CELL PHONE - GPS

Ms. Reitz informed the Board that the initial plan to implement a cell phone locator functionality on the new Nextel cell phones was withdrawn, and this withdrawal was based on the premise that she and Ms. Hockenberry would look into more sophisticated functionality and give notice to the Union of the Board's intent to implement such a system. This notice memo has been drafted and presented to the Office of Collective Bargaining (OCB) and it is currently being researched based on the potential far reaching

impact the decision can have. Ms. Reitz reported that a meeting was scheduled with OCB to discuss our intent to move forward.

CORRESPONDENCE

OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, BUREAU OF ORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Ms. Reitz stated that the Board had received a correspondence from Mark Siegal, DDS, MPH, Chief, Ohio Department of Health, Bureau of Oral Health Services updating the Board on the progress of securing contracts with dentists approved for loan repayment through the Ohio Dentist Loan Repayment Program. She noted that currently there are seven (7) dentists who have qualified for the program.

ANYTHING FOR THE GOOD OF THE BOARD

OHIO DENTAL WORKFORCE ROUNDTABLE

Ms. Naber stated that she and Ms. Hockenberry had attended the Ohio Dental Workforce Roundtable on February 11, 2005. She stated that there were three (3) speakers: L. Jackson Brown, DDS, PhD, an ADA representative who presented on a workforce study of dental care in the state of Wisconsin; Stephen A. Ecklund, DDS, DrPH from the state of Michigan who gave a presentation on a privatized program, Health Kids Dental, which has been highly effective regarding access to care but has most recently come under scrutinization. Ms. Naber stated that the final presenter was Beth Mertz, MPA who spoke "out of the box" in suggesting that access be taken to the people.

Concluding, Ms. Naber stated that the group hoped to have agreed values set in place to develop the workforce around a its next meeting

OHIO STATE DENTAL BOARD MEETING WITH OHIO DENTAL ASSOCIATION

Dr. Beckwith stated that while he did not necessarily agree with the need to meet with the ODA as the officers and directors have done twice now, he understands why the meetings are taking place. He stated that he did have a concern as to the appearance of impropriety in having Board officers meeting with ODA officers at the ODA office. He stated that in his opinion, the Board is a state agency and if the ODA has business to discuss with the board, the meetings should be held at the Board office. Otherwise, arguments could be made by other interested groups that the Board is catering to the ODA, is showing favoritism, and/or is in collusion with the association. Dr. Beckwith

stated that he believes the mission of the ODA is so different from the Board in that the ODA exists to support and promote the interests of the paying dues members. Therefore, he said the Board must avoid any appearance of impropriety, and all meetings between the two groups should take place at the Board office.

Dr. Kyger disagreed and stated that the members of each organization are meeting to improve relations and that the first meeting was held at the Board, so in fairness the second meeting was held at the ODA.

Dr. Vesoulis agreed that there might be an appearance that the Board is conspiring with the group it regulates, and the Board should avoid that.

Dr. Hills stated that he definitely saw the point that Dr. Beckwith was making and that while meetings can continue, the meetings should take place at the Board office to ensure that the appearance is acceptable.

BOARD POSITION STATEMENTS

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF DENTAL EXAMINERS/NORTH EAST REGIONAL BOARD, INC. LICENSURE ISSUES

Dr. Beckwith indicated he thought it was time that the Board take an official position on the issues involving licensure in Ohio. He stated that in his opinion the National Clinical Licensure Examination was long overdue, and he believed it was important that the Board speak with one voice on these matters of significant importance. He stated that he needed to know where Board members stood on the national exam, on alternatives, and what we believed was best in terms of assuring public protection. He stated that in light of the comments made last meeting that positions made by the Board reflect Board member consensus, this should be addressed now.

Dr. Beckwith therefore asked that a vote be taken on the following question:

Motion by Dr. Beckwith, second by Dr. Kyger, that the Board support an independent third-party national clinical examination for licensure.

Motion by Dr. Kyger, second by Ms. Naber, to amend the motion to include valid and reliable third-party examination.

Discussion ensued and the issues of validity and reliability were addressed at some length. Dr. Vesoulis noted that this vote should not be taken with any qualification, and the assumption should be made that this exam in fact would be valid and reliable.

Dr. Kyger rescinded her motion to amend.

Dr. Beckwith rescinded his original motion.

Motion by Dr. Beckwith, second by Ms. Wise, that the Ohio State Dental Board support the concept of a valid and reliable national clinical third party examination.

Roll call vote.

Motion carried unanimously.

PORTFOLIO OR PGY1 LICENSURE

Dr. Beckwith asked for a vote on this next question: Does the Ohio State Dental Board oppose PGY1 or other alternative pathways to licensure to the extent that they do not require an independent third party clinical examination?

Discussion ensued as to this topic. Dr. Wright stated that if this meant that the schools responsible for educating also become responsible for determining eligibility for licensure, then his vote was a strong NO. Dr. Beckwith said his question includes PGY1, and portfolio review, etc.

Dr. Hills stated that he believed it was important to note that the term PGY1 is in itself misleading as PGY1 programs are designed to train dentists who are presumed to have a base line level of education. These programs are not designed to evaluate minimal competence for licensure purposes.

It was agreed that the Board members did not like the phrasing of the question. Dr. Murphy assisted and made the motion as follows:

Motion by Dr. Murphy, second by Ms. Naber that the Ohio State Dental Board support PGY1 and other alternatives to licensure.

RE: Proposed Rule 4715-22-01

As you are aware, the 125th General Assembly enacted several pieces of legislation (SB 51, SB 80, and SB 86) that had components related to the creation of a volunteer's certificate for retired dentists providing free services to indigent and uninsured persons. The Ohio Association of Free Clinics had several concerns related to the rule (4715-22-01) initially filed by the State Dental Board to mirror the language enacted in statute. These concerns were:

- SB 80 removed the requirement for a notarized statement from the applicant stating that the applicant will not accept any form of remuneration. The proposed rule did not delete this requirement.
- The proposed rule required a personal appearance before the State Dental Board, a provision that is not in statute and does not follow the intent of the law to encourage volunteerism.
- The proposed rule did not make changes to the definition of surgery to comport with changes enacted in SB 80 (2305.234(F)(1)(b)).

We understand that the State Dental Board plans to make changes to address all of these concerns in a revised rule. We appreciate the willingness of the State Dental Board to make these revisions so that the rules are in agreement with the legislation and legislative intent. We also are grateful for the hard work of your staff, especially Mindy Franks, for the expeditious filing of this rule and for addressing our concerns in a timely manner.
