CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Vesoulis extended greetings to everyone and noting that there was a quorum present called the meeting to order at 1:18 p.m. He requested all members and guests sign the attendance roster.

OPEN SESSION

The Board resumed open session at 1:30 p.m. Dr. Vesoulis approved the agenda for the afternoon as presented with the notation that the Chair may modify the agenda due to timing constraints or extenuating circumstances.

He then introduced the other Board members: Dr. Edward Hills, the Board Secretary, a general dentist from Cleveland, Dr. Gregory McDonald, the Board Vice-President, a general dentist from Springboro, Dr. Mark Armstrong, a general dentist from Troy, Dr. Phillip Beckwith, an orthodontist from Columbus, Dr. Berta Howard, a general dentist from Hamilton, Dr. Billie Sue Kyger, a general dentist from Gallipolis, Ms. Linda Staley, a dental hygienist from Lima, Ms. Ann Naber, a dental hygienist from Bellbrook, Dr. Greg Wallace, an oral and maxillofacial surgeon from Fairfield, Ms. Sandra Wise, a dental hygienist from Fremont, Dr. Franklin D. Wright, a general dentist from Cincinnati, and Mr. Chad Readler, an attorney and the Board's public member from Columbus.

ENFORCEMENT REPORT

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)

IMPAIRMENT

MICHAEL S. TILSON, D.D.S.

Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Tilson is appearing before the Board for his second interview. She stated that Dr. Tilson continues to be in compliance with his aftercare, all urine screens remain negative, and he is doing well.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Tilson explained that he felt he was doing well and that he had brought a friend along in support to the meeting that day. He stated that he attends several meetings per week and is living on his own in Granville. He stated that there is always temptation and that is why he has chosen to remain in the vicinity of Shepherd Hill as it allows him to be immersed in a community of Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) people. He then briefly reiterated his history with the Board.

Board members questioned Dr. Tilson regarding his return to the practice of dentistry. Dr. Tilson explained that he would like to return to practice in a group practice and was open to either a small or large group. He stated that he does not have any definite jobs lined up but has spoken with a few dentists in the area about associateships. Dr. Tilson explained again that he is not looking to begin practicing full-time, but rather only one to two (1-2) days per week until he is more comfortable.

ENFORCEMENT UPDATE

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board that there were twenty-one (21) cases pending hearings, of which all have been scheduled for hearing. She stated that we still have seven (7) cases under appeal and four (4) cases pending Hearing Officers Report and Recommendation. Ms. Hockenberry stated that the Board would be holding an

evidentiary hearing during its meeting in March and that there are currently twenty-one (21) licensees under suspension. She informed the Board members that one (1) new case has been referred to the Quality Intervention Program (QUIP) since the last Board meeting and we now have nine (9) cases pending QUIP.

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board that sixty-one (61) cases have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretary and are recommended to be closed.

Due to the requirement in Chapter 4715.03(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, that "The board shall not dismiss any complaint or terminate any investigation except by a majority vote of its members,..." Ms. Hockenberry reviewed the cases to be closed with the Board.
