ENFORCEMENT REPORT

PERSONAL APPEARANCES

JOHN GASSER, D.D.S.

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board that Dr. Gasser was appearing for his second personal appearance before the Board. Dr. Gasser stated that he has completed his treatment and is complying with the aftercare program requirements. He informed the Board that he has been drug-free since June of 2004, following required protocols, feeling well, and strong. Dr. Gasser indicated that he wants to get back into practice.

Dr. Vesoulis questioned Dr. Gasser about his activities during his suspension. Dr. Gasser stated that he attends Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) meetings twice a week, caduceus meetings at Cleveland Clinic, and medical appointments that are unrelated to his dependency. He indicated that he enjoys doing devotions, working around his house, and volunteering with Habitat for Humanity. Dr. Gasser stated that he has not practiced for five months. He informed the Board members that he has been taking online courses to remain current and plans to start back into active practice slowly.

MICHAEL POWERS, D.D.S.

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board members that this is Dr. Powers first appearance before them for interview. Dr. Powers stated that he admitted himself to The Cleveland Clinic and reported this to the Board. Upon request of the Board Dr. Powers gave a history of his narcotic use from 1986. He stated that he had initially received treatment at The Cleveland Clinic and did well until Spring 2004. Dr. Powers indicated he had entered a 28-day residential treatment program, started AA, and then went back to work at Case Western Reserve University.

Continuing on, Dr. Powers stated that he again relapsed in February of 2005. Dr. Powers stated he has since completed a 28-day residential treatment program and is currently in a weekly mens group through the clinic. He informed the Board that he is currently helping with new patients at The Cleveland Clinic in their recovery center's "Back to Basic's Program".

Upon questioning by Dr. Vesoulis regarding a support system, Dr. Powers stated that he has a lot of support from his family, professional colleagues and personal friends. He said that on Wednesday nights he meets with a support group of twelve (12). Dr. Howard questioned how this treatment and recovery differs from his previous experience. Dr. Powers stated that recovery is a process of denial at first with other things being more important. However, he stated that he has received more input during the last couple of months which has placed him on the right track in putting his sobriety first.

Dr. Vesoulis stated that it is not the Board's policy to consider reinstatement of an impaired licensee upon the first interview. He then invited Dr. Powers to appear before the Board again in June.

PETER G. WOLFRAM, JR., D.D.S.

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board that this was Dr. Wolfram's initial appearance before the Board. Dr. Wolfram stated that eight months ago he began having marital problems which he did not handle well. He stated that his way of handling the problems was with drugs and alcohol. Dr. Wolfram indicated that this continued for several months during which time he became addicted to cocaine.

Dr. Wolfram informed the Board that he was arrested and spent 28 days in jail on charges involving cocaine. Afterwards, he stated that he had checked into a detoxification program, attended an intensive outpatient program (IOP) for 9 hours per week and is currently enrolled in Comprehensive Addication Service System (COMPASS). Dr. Wolfram stated that he currently attends AA seven (7) times a week. Dr. Vesoulis asked Dr. Wolfram if he is under the care of a physician. Dr. Wolfram replied that he is receiving treatment from a physician for a previously diagnosed condition that was reconfirmed during his stay at the detoxification center.

Upon questioning by the Board regarding the pending criminal charges, Dr. Wolfram stated he has a pretrial hearing scheduled for May 9, 2005. Dr. McDonald asked Dr. Wolfram about his activities during this time. Dr. Wolfram stated that he was permitted to go to the office during previously arranged hours, however, he is not permitted to see patients. He stated that he is required to wear an electronic monitor which tracks his movements through his set schedule. He stated that the schedule includes meetings four (4) hours per day, AA meetings and his IOP. He stated that he reads and works out most of the rest of his time. When asked by Dr. Vesoulis regarding his practice, Dr. Wolfram stated that he has a hygienist and periodontist that work in office, in addition to a retired dentist who works in the office six (6) hours a week.

Dr. Vesoulis stated that the Board would not be considering reinstatement of Dr. Wolfram's license today and invited him to reappear before the board in June.

**REVIEW OF CASES WHEREIN NOTICE(S) OF OPPORTUNITY
WERE ISSUED AND NO HEARING WAS REQUESTED**

REBECCA L. MOILOV, R.D.H.

Dr. Vesoulis turned the meeting over to Dr. Hills to conduct the evidentiary review. Dr. Hills then stated for the record:

“This is an evidentiary review in the matter of Rebecca L. Moilov, R.D.H., pursuant to Chapters 119 and 4715 of the Ohio Revised Code. The purpose of this proceeding is to give the Board information about this matter, in lieu of the Administrative Hearing that would have occurred if

Ms. Moilov had requested a hearing. The Board's minutes will serve as the official record of this proceeding."

Dr. Hills asked if the State would like to present any additional information to support the charges outlined in the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing.

Mr. Fulkerson said yes and called Ms. Rebecca Hockenberry, Assistant Director of the Dental Board, to give testimony in this matter. Dr. Hills asked Ms. Hockenberry to raise her right hand and said:

"Do you swear that the testimony you are about to give will be the truth so help you God?"

Ms. Hockenberry said yes and upon questioning by Mr. Fulkerson she described her duties as the Assistant Director of the Dental Board. She stated she oversees the enforcement unit of the Dental Board.

Mr. Fulkerson proceeded to address State's Exhibits 1 thorough 4 by asking Ms. Hockenberry questions regarding each Exhibit. Ms. Hockenberry identified State's Exhibit 1 as a copy of Rebecca L. Moilov's signed dental hygiene licensure renewal application dated December 20, 2003. Ms. Hockenberry pointed out that Ms. Moilov had marked the "yes" block indicating that she had completed twelve hours of continuing education (CE) during the 2002-2003 biennium and was currently certified in basic life support.

Ms. Hockenberry stated that Ms. Moilov was selected for a random continuing education audit. She indicated that State's Exhibit 2 is a copy of a letter dated September 1, 2002 from the Ohio State Dental Board to Ms. Moilov informing her that she had been selected for an audit of her continuing education and requesting that she submit documentation evidencing her continuing education experience for the 2002-2003 biennium within fourteen (14) days. This letter was sent by regular U.S. mail and that Ms. Moilov did not respond to this request. Ms. Hockenberry noted for the record that the name, license number and address on the letter is the same as that indicated on State's Exhibit 1.

Exhibit No. 3 is a Final Notice letter dated November 16, 2004 to Ms. Moilov notifying her that we had not received a response to the audit request and that this was the Board's final request to provide documentation of her CE. The deadline for providing the requested information was December 1, 2004 and that this letter was sent by certified mail. Rebecca Moilov had signed the certified mail receipt card on November 19, 2004. Ms. Hockenberry stated that the Board has received no contact either verbally or in writing from Ms. Moilov regarding this final notice of request for CE audit.

As a result of Ms. Moilov's failure to comply, the Board issued a Notice of Automatic Suspension and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing on February 15, 2005 which was also mailed out certified mail receipt. Ms. Hockenberry indicated that page two of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, Ms. Moilov is entitled to a hearing in this matter, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119. Such request for hearing must be made within thirty (30) days of the mailing of the Notice. Ms. Moilov signed the certified mail receipt card on February 22, 2005 and returned it to the Board office but did not request a hearing in this matter.

Concluding, Ms. Hockenberry stated that she personally attempted to contact Ms. Moilov via telephone but was unable to speak with her. Ms. Hockenberry stated that Ms. Moilov's phone was answered by a generic voicemail message and therefore, she left a message to Ms. Moilov but has not received a response to that call.

Mr. Fulkerson stated that he had no further evidence to present and requested that State's Exhibit's 1 through 4 be entered into evidence.

DENTAL HYGIENE RADIOGRAPHY CURRICULUMS

Motion by Dr. Armstrong, second by Ms. Leshner, that the Board executive office accept all radiology curriculums included in American Dental Association accredited dental

hygiene programs as acceptable dental assistant radiographer initial training programs when presented to the Board by dental hygiene students for radiographer licensure.

Discussion followed wherein it was clarified that dental hygiene students complete their radiography curriculums during the first semester of their ADA-accredited dental hygiene programs. It was explained that the curriculums are six to eight (6-8) weeks in duration and covered the seven (7) curriculum requirements set forth in the Dental Practice Act. Ms. Naber indicated that this motion would allow the dental hygiene student to take one (1) of the approved radiography examinations and then apply for licensure, thus allowing the students to practice as dental assistant radiographers for the duration of their studies if they chose to work in dental offices part-time and during school breaks.

Further discussion clarified that dental assistant radiographer licenses issued to the students would then lapse and would not be required to be renewed once the student was appropriately licensed as a dental hygienist subsequent to graduation and successful completion of a regional board examination.

Roll call vote.

Motion carried unanimously.

Dr. Vesoulis then stated that Ms. Lynda Sabat will be added as a member to the Education Committee since her previous experience will prove invaluable during the review of the Education rules this year.

LAW AND RULES REVIEW COMMITTEE REPORT

Dr. Vesoulis stated that the Law and Rule Review Committee had met briefly earlier in the day to begin their review of the rules for 2005. He stated that the Education rules, Ohio Administrative Code sections 4715-8-01 through 4715-8-04, had been referred to the Education Committee for review and recommendation for changes and that the Advertising rules, OAC 4715-13-03 and 4715-13-04, have been referred to the Board's Executive and Assistant Directors for recommended changes. The rule regarding the licensure of dental graduates of unaccredited programs located outside the United States will be reviewed by the Executive Director and committee member Keith Kerns, Esq. of the Ohio Dental Association.

Dr. Vesoulis stated that the committee would meet again in June to discuss any proposed changes to the Advertising rules and begin discussions on recommended changes to OAC 4715-18-01.

SCOPE OF PRACTICE COMMITTEE REPORT

Dr. Hills reported that the Scope of Practice Committee met earlier in the day and decided that it was within the scope of practice of Expanded Function Dental Auxiliary (EFDA) to use high-speed handpieces to trim, finish and polish restorations. He stated that it was the determination of the Committee that implants are within the scope of practice of dentists specializing in endodontics.

SECRETARY'S EXPENSE REPORT

Dr. Hills attested that he had spent in excess of twenty (20) hours per week attending to Board business.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

GOVERNOR'S CONSOLIDATION PLAN

Ms. Reitz provided a summary of the testimony before the Ohio Senate on House Bill 66 regarding the consolidation of twenty-seven (27) regulatory boards and commissions into the Ohio Department of Health, Department of Public Safety, or Department of Commerce. Ms. Reitz stated that there has been an amendment to the original bill, which excludes seven (7) of the larger boards and commissions including the Dental Board to consolidate from the proposal.

Ms. Reitz continued by stating that copies of excerpts from Amended Substitute House Bill 66 were also included in the Board notebooks also. She stated there will be ongoing testimony regarding an alternative consolidation plan that includes language to consolidate the regulatory boards and commissions into the Department of Administrative Services, and build upon existing efficiencies via the Central Service Agency.

SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 117

Ms. Reitz informed the Board that copies of her testimony along with a copy of Substitute House Bill 117 regarding alternative healthcare services had been provided in the Board notebooks for their review. She stated that key points of concern are line 159 which states: "Complimentary or alternative health care treatment means a method of treating an individual's health condition that is designed to be an alternative to prevailing or conventional methods use to treat the health condition. Complimentary or alternative health care treatment may be provided in addition to or in place of other treatment options." Ms. Reitz stated that this definition would allow an unlicensed individual to provide treatment to include any number of areas, since it is not specific in its listing of acceptable treatments.

Additionally, Ms. Reitz stated that line 177 states: "That the regulation or licensure of complimentary or alternative healthcare service providers is inappropriate and unnecessary." She commented that this language raises concerns since complimentary or alternative health care treatments are not specifically defined, it would allow unlicensed and unregulated individuals carte blanche approval to practice alternative health care, regardless of credentials.

In addition to the aforementioned concerns, Ms. Reitz indicated that paragraph (D), line 132 allows a license holder whose license was subsequently revoked to provide complementary or alternative health care services under certain circumstances. She expressed that she believed the regulatory boards and the legislature have an obligation to the most vulnerable of Ohio's citizens to ensure that health care providers have the skills and education necessary to provide competent treatment.

Ms. Reitz stated that the Ohio State Medical Board and Ohio Board of Pharmacy provided opposing testimony in addition to the Dental Board's testimony regarding this Bill.

OHIO PHYSICIANS HEALTH PROGRAM – MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Ms. Reitz indicated that a copy of a letter to Stan Sateren, MD of the Ohio Physicians Health Program (OPHP) had been supplied in the Board notebooks for review. She indicated that it had come to the Board's attention at a recent Committee of Six meeting that OPHP had declined monitoring services for a disciplined licensee that is not a dentist. Ms. Reitz explained that the verbage in the Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) between OPHP and the Board permits OPHP to address the impairment needs of dentists only. However, she stated that this letter was to clarify that it is the Board's intent that OPHP was to provide these services to all Board licensees and that she wanted clarification and/or an updated agreement that would not in any way limit services to our licensees. She stated that OPHP will be holding its Board of Trustees meeting in May and we will await any response.

CORRESPONDENCE

AMERICAN DENTAL ASSOCIATION - RESPONSE

Dr. Vesoulis informed the members that included in the Board notebooks was his response to the American Dental Association (ADA) regarding the Board's opposition to the ADA's "efforts to create and oversee the administration of a clinical dental licensing examination."

Discussion ensued wherein Dr. Kyger and Ms. Naber expressed their discontent for not having the opportunity to discuss this issue prior to a response. It was expressed that it was difficult for them as members to support issues in efforts to protect the public when they have little or no knowledge of the topics.

Dr. Vesoulis informed the members that the basis for the letter restated the Board's mission statement and supported the Boards' already on-going efforts and participation in the American Board of Dental Examiners, Inc. (AADE) which has spent significant time and effort in developing a valid, reliable, and legally defensible clinical examination. He stated that historically the Board has supported the notion that regulatory boards are responsible for the examination and licensure of dentists and dental hygienists, and that that professional associations, whether local, state or national should not interfere with this primary board function. He stated this letter reiterates that longstanding position.

NORTH EAST REGIONAL BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS, INC.

Ms. Reitz informed the Board members that copies of a letter from the North East Regional Board of Dental Examiners, Inc. (NERB) regarding the search for Consultant

Members and the Board's Policy on Consultant Membership had been provided in the Board notebooks for their review. She stated that should any of the members know of anyone interested they could submit the names to the Board executive office.

ANYTHING FOR THE GOOD OF THE BOARD

RDH MAGAZINE ARTICLE – LYNDA SABAT, RDH

Dr. Vesoulis stated that copies of a recent article in RDH Magazine on Immediate Past President, Lynda Sabat, R.D.H. had been included in the Board notebooks. He indicated that the article highlighted Ms. Sabat's accomplishments, which included her tenure on the Board, and was highly complimentary.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Ms. Reitz informed attendees that the Board would be going into Executive Session but upon returning to Open Session there would be no additional Board business to discuss.
