It is hereby ORDERED:

- 1. The license of Michael J. Misencik, D.D.S. to practice dentistry in the state of Ohio, including all permits issued by the Ohio State Dental Board, shall be SUSPENDED INDEFINITELY for a minimum period of time of at least nine (9) months, in accordance with ORC § 4715.30 (A)(8), due to said licensee's violation of Count 1 as set forth in the Board's Notice of Opportunity for Hearing dated November 2, 2005. Additionally, Dr. Misencik's license shall be SUSPENDED INDEFINITELY for a minimum period of time of at least two (2) weeks, which shall run consecutively to the nine (9) month suspension, in accordance with ORC § 4715.14 (C), due to said licensee's violation of Count 2 as set forth in the Board's Notice of Opportunity for Hearing dated November 2, 2005. Dr. Misencik shall immediately refer all his patients who may need treatment within that time period to other practitioners.*

- A. *No one in the dental office may perform dentistry or dental hygiene duties or otherwise treat patients during the period of suspension.*
 - B. *A receptionist may answer the phones with "Dr. Misencik's Office", or the name of the practice, or the sole purpose of answering questions, scheduling/rescheduling appointments, and making referrals.*
 - C. *Dr. Misencik may not receive any income either from a legal or a beneficial interest in the dental practice during the period of suspension, however, he may be present in the office to update records, and do other duties as necessary to bring his office into compliance with the Dental Practice Act and to establish procedures to ensure continued compliance.*
2. *The Ohio State Dental Board shall not consider REINSTATEMENT of Dr. Misencik's license to practice dentistry and all permits issued by the Board unless all of the following minimum requirements have been met:*
- A. *Dr. Misencik shall submit an application for reinstatement, accompanied by appropriate fees. Dr. Misencik shall not make application until his suspension has been completed.*
 - B. *Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order, or as otherwise approved by the Board, Dr. Misencik shall submit to appropriate treatment, as determined by an informed assessment of Dr. Misencik's needs. Such assessment and treatment shall be by an approved treatment provider(s) for drug and alcohol dependency. Prior to initial assessment, Dr. Misencik shall provide the approved provider with copies of the Board's Order in this matter (including any documents attached and incorporated by reference) and the Board may provide any other documentation it deems necessary and/or helpful to the provider.*
- Within ten (10) days after completion of the initial assessment, or as otherwise determined by the Board, Dr. Misencik shall cause a written report to be submitted to the Board from the approved provider, which shall include:*

- i. A detailed plan of recommended treatment based on the treatment provider's informed assessment of the Dr. Misencik's current needs;*
 - ii. A statement indicating that Dr. Misencik entered into or commenced the recommended treatment program within 48 hours of its determination;*
 - iii. A copy of a treatment contract signed by the Dr. Misencik, establishing the terms of treatment and aftercare, including any required supervision or restrictions of practice during treatment or aftercare, and;*
 - iv. A statement indicating that the treatment provider will immediately report to the Board any failure by Dr. Misencik to comply with the terms of the treatment contract during inpatient or outpatient treatment or aftercare.*
- C. Dr. Misencik shall provide the Board with acceptable documentation evidencing compliance with the plan of recommendation treatment required under paragraph 2B hereof.*
- D. Dr. Misencik shall sign a written release which authorizes the Board to have access to all treatment information and documentation.*
- E. Dr. Misencik shall submit to an evaluation from a physician approved in advance by the Board Secretary. Dr. Misencik shall ensure that the approved physician submits a written report directly to the Board stating that Respondent is no longer drug or alcohol dependent and is able to practice dentistry in accordance with the accepted standards of the professions.*

The report shall state with particularity the bases for this determination and shall set forth any recommended limitation upon Respondent's practice.

- F. Dr. Misencik shall ensure that the approved treatment provider provides directly to the Board certification that he has successfully completed any required inpatient treatment and is continuing full compliance with regard to any outpatient treatment and/or aftercare.*
- G. Dr. Misencik shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in a drug and alcohol rehabilitation program acceptable to the Board, such as AA, NA, or Caduceus, no less than three (3) times per week, or as otherwise directed by the Board.*
- 3. Upon completion of the suspension set forth in paragraph 1 of this Order and proper reinstatement of his dental license by the Board, Dr. Misencik may resume the practice of dentistry in the state of Ohio, but his license shall be subjected to the following PROBATIONARY conditions for a period of no less than three (3) years:*
- A. Dr. Misencik shall abstain completely from the personal use or possession of drugs, except those prescribed, dispensed or administered for the Respondent's use by another so authorized by law who has full knowledge of Dr. Misencik's history of chemical dependency.*
- B. Dr. Misencik shall abstain completely from the use of alcohol.*
- C. Ms. Hockenberry stated that Dr. Bruner's attorney had requested and had been granted permission to address the board prior to its deliberation in this matter.

Dr. Hills then stated that the Board's minutes would serve as the official record of the proceedings. He then asked if Dr. Bruner and/or his attorney were present. Recognizing that Dr. Bruner's attorney, Douglas Graff, Esq., he stated that Mr. Graff's comments should be limited to the Report and Recommendation filed by the Hearing Examiner.

DOUGLAS E. GRAFF, ESQ.

Douglas E. Graff, Esq., attorney for Richard E. Bruner, D.D.S., began by apologizing for Dr. Bruner's inability to appear before them at this time due to pressing family matters. He then stated that the Board alleged that Dr. Bruner had: 1) failed to seek approval and to then complete required continuing education; 2) secure a monitoring dentist to review Dr. Bruner's practice; and 3) failed to obey all federal, state and local laws related to the practice of dentistry on two (2) occasions.

Mr. Graff stated that the Hearing Examiner recommends dismissal of two (2) of the four (4) counts and argued that the Hearing Examiner recognized a good faith effort by Dr. Bruner in that he had submitted Continuing Medical Education (CME) [sic] to the Board for pre-approval prior to the ratification of the consent agreement. However, he stated that Dr. Bruner's attempt to immediately comply received no response from the Board due to the time lapse in ratification of the consent agreement and therefore, if not for the failure of the Board to respond, Dr. Bruner would have at least completed some of the required continuing education. Mr. Graff stated that in addition, Dr. Bruner's personal circumstances, i.e. employee theft, mismanagement and fraud, personal bankruptcy and vicious divorce, precluded Dr. Bruner from fulfilling the Board's requirements of the consent agreement.

Regarding Count 2 of the Notice of opportunity for hearing, Mr. Graff stated that the Hearing Examiner recommended that this count be dismissed based again on the Board's lack of response. He stated that Hearing Examiner recognized a good faith effort on Dr. Bruner's part to attempt to obtain a monitor for his practice in that he timely supplied to the Board the name of a qualified dentist willing to serve in this capacity as monitor. Mr. Graff agreed with the Hearing Examiner's finding that this Count should be dismissed.

Continuing on, Mr. Graff stated that with regards to Counts 3 and 4, the Board has no authority to enforce "federal, state and local laws" but rather only those laws relating

to the practice of dentistry and cannot expand its jurisdiction beyond that delegated by the General Assembly.

Concluding, Mr. Graff stated that the Hearing Examiner's recommendation for additional nine (9) months suspended practice is unreasonable in light of his time already served out of practice and they [Dr. Bruner] are requesting that he be permitted to quickly return to the active practice of dentistry. He stated that Dr. Bruner understands completely and fully what it expected of him in regards to continuing education and intends to comply with requirements as set forth by the Board. Mr. Graff then requested that the Board deliberate this matter in open session.

BARBARA PFEIFFER, ESQ., ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL

Barbara Pfeiffer, Esq., Assistant Attorney General representing the Board in this case, began by stating that Count 2 of the Notice of opportunity for hearing in this matter charged Dr. Bruner with failure to ensure monitoring of patient charts by an approved monitor and the failure of Dr. Bruner to ensure that these reports were submitted to the Board on a quarterly basis. She clarified that the Hearing Examiner found that the Board failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence that Dr. Vieson was not formally approved by the Board to serve as Dr. Bruner's monitor under the terms of the consent agreement. Ms. Pfeiffer explained that there was no burden on the Board to prove that Dr. Vieson was/was not formally approved by the Board, but rather it was the burden of the Board to provide proof that Dr. Bruner failed to ensure that quarterly reports were filed by a monitoring dentist approved in advance by the Board, and the Board did just that.

Ms. Pfeiffer further explained that evidence submitted indicated that in January 2005, three (3) months after ratification of the consent agreement by the Board, Dr. Bruner supplied the name of Dr. Vieson as a potential monitoring dentist and that Dr. Vieson was sent a letter [State's Exhibit 6] outlining the various duties/responsibilities required of him under the consent agreement as a monitor. She stated that the letter specifically states:

Should you still wish to serve as Dr. Bruner's monitor, please advise and I will forward this information to the Board Secretary.

Ms. Pfeiffer stated that there was no further evidence in the record to indicate that Dr. Vieson responded indicating he wished to be Dr. Bruner's monitoring dentist. She clarified that nothing was received directly from Dr. Vieson, or indirectly via Dr. Bruner to support that Dr. Vieson had agreed to the terms set forth in the letter.

Mr. Readler asked Ms. Pfeiffer if this letter was typical with regards to monitoring cases. Ms. Pfeiffer responded that she did not know and therefore could not respond to that question.

Continuing on, Ms. Pfeiffer stated that with regards to Dr. Bruner's conviction, the Hearing Examiner dismissed this Count due to an error made in the case number indicated in the Notice of opportunity for hearing. She stated that it is apparent from State's Exhibit 8 that a typographical error exists in Count 4. However, Ms. Pfeiffer indicated that Dr. Bruner did not dispute that he received a copy of State's Exhibit 8 before the hearing and that the first page of the exhibit indicated that Dr. Bruner was arrested on May 25, 2005 for the charge of Telecommunication Harassment in Hamilton County.

Ms. Pfeiffer indicated that the Board has evidence that Dr. Bruner was arrested for the offense of Telecommunication Harassment and the he did in fact plead guilty to and was found guilty of an amended charge of disorderly conduct. Therefore, she stated that there was sufficient evidence for the Board to find that Count 4 of the Notice of opportunity had been proven by a preponderance of the evidence and leaves the Hearing Examiner's recommendation for dismissal to the discretion of the Board.

Concluding, Ms. Pfeiffer stated that with regards to Count 1 of the Notice of opportunity for hearing, Dr. Bruner acknowledges that he failed to complete the 160 additional hours of continuing education within the nine (9) months. However, Ms. Pfeiffer noted that there was no documentation or evidence indicating that Dr. Bruner took any additional continuing education as required. She emphasized that it was not as though Dr. Bruner had not completed 140 of the 160 required hours; but rather he had completed none of the required hours.

- 2. The Ohio State Dental Board shall not consider REINSTATEMENT of Dr. Bruner's license to practice dentistry and all permits issued by the Board unless all of the following minimum requirements have been met:*
 - A. Dr. Bruner shall submit an application for reinstatement, accompanied by appropriate fees. Dr. Bruner shall not make application until his suspension has been completed.*
 - B. Dr. Bruner shall provide documentation that he has successfully completed the one hundred sixty (160) hours of continuing education originally set forth in the Consent Agreement between himself and the*

- Board, and approved by the Board on November 3, 2004. Namely, Dr. Bruner shall complete the 160 hours of continuing education in pediatric dentistry, including diagnosis and treatment planning and restorative dentistry, including the proper use of restorative materials and techniques, at an American Dental Association accredited post-graduate program in pediatric dentistry. All hours must be pre-approved by the Board Secretary and are in addition to the forty (40) hours of continuing education required for renewal of Dr. Bruner's license pursuant to ORC 4715.141. Any hours not pre-approved by the Board will not count toward the 160 hour requirement hereunder.*
- 3. Upon completion of the suspension set forth in paragraph 1 of this Order and proper reinstatement of his dental license by the Board, Dr. Bruner may resume the practice of dentistry in the state of Ohio but his orthodontic treatment shall be limited to the following procedures: interceptive orthodontic treatment including expansion, cross-bite correction, space maintenance and retention appliances, and Class I skeletal and dental non-extraction malocclusions cases. Dr. Bruner shall not perform any growth modification treatment procedures.*
 - 4. Upon completion of the suspension set forth in paragraph 1 of this Order and proper reinstatement of his dental license by the Board, Dr. Bruner shall refer all orthodontic patients to other practitioners except for those patients he is permitted to treat in accordance with paragraph 3 of this Order.*
 - 5. Upon completion of the suspension set forth in paragraph 1 of this Order and proper reinstatement of his dental license by the Board, Dr. Bruner may resume the practice of dentistry in the state of Ohio, but his license shall be subject to the following PROBATIONARY terms, conditions and limitations for a period of no less than three (3) years:*
 - A. Dr. Bruner's practice shall be monitored by a dentist approved in advance by the Board Secretary. Dr. Bruner shall see no patients once his practice resumes unless an approved monitor is in place. The monitoring dentist shall review Dr. Bruner's charts and/or patients and shall submit a written report of such review on a quarterly basis. The chart review shall be done on a random basis, with the number of charts reviewed to be determined by the Board Secretary. The monitoring*

dentist shall provide the Board with reports on Dr. Bruner's progress and status and on the status of sixty (60) patient charts on a quarterly basis. All monitoring dentist reports required under this paragraph must be received in the Board office no later than the fifteenth of each month. It is Dr. Bruner's responsibility to ensure that the reports are timely submitted.

In the event that the approved monitoring dentist becomes unavailable or unwilling to serve, Dr. Bruner shall immediately notify the Board in writing and shall make arrangements for another monitoring dentist as soon as possible. Any subsequent monitoring dentist shall be approved in advance by the Board Secretary. Dr. Bruner shall ensure that the previously designated monitoring dentist also notifies the Board directly of his or her inability to continue to serve and the reasons therefore. The costs of any monitoring dentist shall be borne by Dr. Bruner.

B. Dr. Bruner shall fully cooperate in the Board's inspection and/or evaluation of his dental office, which shall occur as often as the Board deems necessary to ensure compliance with the Dental Practice Act, Chapter 4715 of the Ohio Revised Code.

C. Dr. Bruner shall appear before the Board or its designee as requested by the Board.

D. Dr. Bruner shall obey all federal, state and local laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio.

6. Upon successful completion of his probation, Dr. Bruner's license and permits shall be fully RESTORED and Dr. Bruner's practice may resume subject only to any limitations placed upon it by paragraphs 3 and 4 of this Order.

This ORDER shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing of the Order.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)

LISA M. HERZNER, DENTAL ASSISTANT RADIOGRAPHER

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board members that this is Ms. Herzner's first appearance before the Board subsequent to treatment and discharge from the Alcohol and Drug Addictions Partners in Treatment (ADAPT) program for women in Cincinnati, Ohio. She explained that Ms. Herzner had been arrested for heroin possession in January 2004 and entered into Hamilton County Treatment in Lieu of Conviction program. Ms. Hockenberry stated that Ms. Herzner entered inpatient treatment on June 14, 2005 and was released from residential treatment on September 12, 2005 to begin outpatient treatment which was completed on June 15, 2006. She stated that ADAPT has informed the Board that Ms. Herzner remains compliant with her treatment and that all drug screens have been negative. Additionally, Ms. Hockenberry stated that ADAPT informed the Board that Ms. Herzner has consistently provided their office with documentation of attendance to at least three (3) Narcotics Anonymous/Alcoholics Anonymous (NA/AA) meetings as required. Ms. Hockenberry then stated that Ms. Herzner has not practiced in the dental field for approximately two (2) years and is looking forward to having her radiographer's license reinstated.

Upon questioning by the Board, Ms. Herzner stated that she is doing much better and has learned a lot about behavior and corrective thinking. She stated that she currently holds two (2) jobs; she performs catering and the other one is at McDonalds. She said that she keeps busy with her baby and enjoys working with people. Ms. Herzner stated that it was a shame that it had to come to this but that after sixteen (16) months of sobriety this has been a good thing.

When asked how she would handle the stress of the dental office, Ms. Herzner replied that stressful situations for her had been at home and not in the dental office. She stated that when she had worked in the dental office, she had worked for two (2)

terrific dentists in a slow-paced office that had a relaxed atmosphere. Dr. Beckwith stated that most home problems lend themselves to addictions of alcohol not heroin and asked Ms. Herzner how she came to dull her stress/problems with heroin. Ms. Herzner replied that the word "heroin" is big, however, part of abusing is the self-destruction of which she is not proud. She stated that she has learned how not to judge others along the way and is now a much better person for her understanding.

Dr. Armstrong asked Ms. Herzner how she handles the stress now to which she responded that she attends NA and AA meetings and has many friends now who do not drink or smoke. She stated that she has a sober network along with the support of her family, currently in Arizona, who will be moving back to Ohio in a few months.

Dr. Vesoulis stated that since this was Ms. Herzner's first appearance before the Board they would like for her to return to discuss this further with the Board during the September meeting. He applauded Ms. Herzner's efforts and suggested that she keep on the path to recovery in the meantime.

DOUGLAS W. SULLIVAN, R.D.H.

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board members that this is Mr. Sullivan's first appearance before the Board. She explained that Mr. Sullivan had entered into a consent agreement with the Board in March, 2001 but had relapsed in September, 2004. She stated that Mr. Sullivan had admitted to relapsing and pleading guilty to a felony DUI, due to multiple convictions, was sentenced to a prison term of twenty (20) months. Ms. Hockenberry explained that while incarcerated, Mr. Sullivan was administratively charged and an adjudication hearing was held wherein his license to practice dental hygiene was indefinitely suspended for a period of no less than nine (9) months and requirements were stipulated for reinstatement. Ms. Hockenberry stated that Mr. Sullivan is compliant with all the requirements for reinstatement to date and is also compliant with all the terms of his original consent agreement.

Upon questioning by the Board, Mr. Sullivan stated that he feels privileged to be before the Board and apologized for the last time, as he now recognizes that it was just "lip service" to get his license back to practice dental hygiene. He stated that he is sincerely sorry for what he did and knows that he was just playing mind games in fooling others and trying to get away with everything and everyone. He stated that he had been drinking all his life from the time he was fifteen (15) years old. Mr. Sullivan explained that details of his last DUI which included driving 90-100 MPH and that he is thankful that no one was hurt.

Continuing on Mr. Sullivan commented that prison was a very big wake-up call for him in that it sobered him up enough to realize that he did not want to spend the rest of

his life there. He stated that his rehabilitation was both needed and wanted as he absorbed everything and continues to pray. He informed the Board that he has been sober for two (2) years but cannot say that it has come easy and still finds it difficult to deal with stressful situations. However, he commented that he has had several chances and realizes that if he messes up now then he deserves what he gets, since he feels to drink would make him a threat to society. He stated that when he was before the Board the last time he did not really want to quit and continued doing the same things but expecting different results.

Dr. Vesoulis stated that since this was Mr. Sullivan's first appearance before the Board they would like for him to return to discuss this further with the Board during the September meeting.

JAMES BUTLER, D.D.S.

Ms. Hockenberry stated that Dr. Butler was here before the Board today to request permission to prescribe Schedule II drugs. She briefly reviewed Dr. Butler's history and explained that during his last appearance before the Board in June, 2004 the Board members had discussed and reviewed a letter received from Dr. Richard Whitney of Shepherd Hill and at that time, felt that Dr. Butler should continue to only prescribe Schedule III-V drugs for at least one (1) additional year.

Dr. Butler stated that he is requesting the Board's approval to begin prescribing Schedule II drugs. He stated that he would like to begin getting back into surgery, implants and cosmetic makeovers. He stated that he currently works with another oral surgeon prescribing in cases where it is appropriate. However, Dr. Butler stated that he has been increasingly performing more of these types of cases and it has become inconvenient for the patient since their records must be reviewed by the other oral surgeon.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Butler explained that he has dealt with plenty of temptation over the past four and a half (4 ½) years but continues to work his program. Dr. Beckwith asked if it would not be prudent to continue on as he has and Dr. Butler responded that the structure of his practice has changed and reiterated that he is not asking to keep any Schedule II drugs on hand, but rather, asking for the ability to prescribe only.

Motion by Dr. McDonald, second by Dr. Wallace to allow Dr. Butler to prescribe Schedule II medications with monitoring by the Board for a period of six (6) months and allow the Board to review patient records at their discretion.

Roll call vote.

CLEON A. FLOWERS, D.D.S.

Ms. Hockenberry reviewed Dr. Flower's history with the Board and explained that he was before them today requesting a new license to practice dentistry in Ohio. She stated that he has continued working towards complying with all the terms of his consent agreement with the Board.

Dr. Flowers began by thanking the Board for the opportunity to speak with them and stated that he feels he would now be a much better dentist since he has completed the two (2) years at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry and subsequent passing of the North East Regional Board, Inc. (NERB) examination. He commented that his sacrifice has been on the positive side in that he was not prepared originally and had to remain focused each and every day in order to comply and perform the best he could at the University of Michigan.

James C. Lee, Esq., Attorney for Cleon A. Flowers, D.D.S., introduced himself and commented that going back to dental school at Dr. Flowers' age had been difficult even without the additional requirement of passing the NERB examination. He stated that he felt this was a tremendous accomplishment by Dr. Flowers. Mr. Lee said that this had come at great personal sacrifice to Dr. Flowers to complete all that the Board has required and is now asking that the Board honestly consider granting Dr. Flowers a license to practice dentistry in Ohio.

Dr. Hills commented that he was the only remaining member of the Board who originally mandated the requirements for Dr. Flowers. He said that none of the members of the Board at that time felt that he would complete the requirements, which included making him a sophomore in dental school again. He commended Dr. Flowers on this accomplishment and questioned/compared Dr. Flowers experiences between Meharry Medical College, School of Dentistry (Meharry) vs. the University of Michigan, School of Dentistry (Michigan).

Dr. Flowers informed Dr. Hills and the Board that both dental schools were difficult but because he did not feel computer-literate, he felt that Michigan was more difficult. He stated that initially he did not feel that the instruction would be that different, but ultimately Michigan was more essay-based, whereas Meharry was case examination-based. Dr. Flowers noted that the biggest difference is that now a dentist needs to know more medicine and that the skill level has not changed so much as the developmental level of knowledge.

Dr. Wright stated that he had read Dr. Flowers' record and noted where he had cut corners in the past. He then questioned whether Dr. Flowers has a passion for dentistry and whether he will now value the profession. Dr. Flowers responded that he has always wanted to be a dentist and will uphold the ethical standards with regards to the treatment of patients. He stated that he was giving the Board his word that he will not disappoint them again.

Dr. Howard noted that he was also applying for a license in Pennsylvania and asked if he intended on practicing there. Dr. Flowers stated that he was required to obtain his Ohio license prior to applying for a license to practice in Pennsylvania but has received a couple of offers for practice there.
