Wright, a general dentist from Cincinnati.

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION IN THE MATTER OF STUART L. DUCHON, D.D.S.

Dr. Hills announced that the Board would now consider the Hearing Officer's Report and Recommendation in the matter of Stuart L. Duchon, D.D.S. that was filed by Hearing Examiner, Sharon W. Murphy, RN, Esq., on May 4, 2007.

The original Order, Report and Recommendation and any objections shall be maintained in the exhibits section of this journal.

Dr. Hills then stated that the Board's minutes would serve as the official record of the proceedings. He then asked if Dr. Duchon and/or his attorney, Frank Recker, Esq., were present.

FRANK R. RECKER, D.D.S., ESQ.

Dr. Duchon's attorney, Frank R. Recker, D.D.S., Esq., introduced himself to the Board. He stated that one of the toughest jobs as a Board member previously, was the opportunity to hold hearings and to hear the testimony and review the evidence in order to come to a conclusion with regards to a licensee. He stated that the Board does not have that opportunity now due to time constraints. Mr. Recker explained that he videotaped the hearing as he wanted the Board to see that Dr. Duchon was not a "cowboy" but that he was in reality a very mild-mannered, non-confrontational man. Mr. Recker further explained that at the time this all began, Dr. Duchon had reached the limits in both his professional and personal life and was not behaving rationally. He stated that on April 6, 2006 Dr. Duchon had been shocked to find that he had not renewed his

license and on the following day, April 7, 2006 he had attempted to gather his continuing education (CE), as well as other documentation to reinstate his license to practice. Mr. Recker continued by explaining that after Dr. Duchon's license was reinstated it was discovered that he did not have the four hours of required continuing education in substance abuse or infection control. He stated that Dr. Duchon panicked when confronted with his lack of required continuing education. Mr. Recker stated that at that time, Dr. Duchon did not respond normally. He stated that Dr. Duchon created a document by cutting and pasting together the information to make it look like a real CE certificate had been issued. Mr. Recker stipulated that these are not the actions of a rational man.

Mr. Recker concluded by stating that Dr. Duchon thought that this matter was resolved long ago, that he has suffered incredibly since that time, and then Mr. Recker requested that the Board reject the Hearing Examiner's recommended order. He suggested that the Board return an order similar to the terms that Dr. Duchon had accepted in good faith upon reinstatement of his license to practice dentistry in April 2006.

JONATHAN FULKERSON, ESQ.

The Board's attorney representative, Deputy Attorney General Jonathan Fulkerson, began by reviewing with the Board the continuing education required by an Ohio licensed dentist in order to maintain their license to practice dentistry. He stated that Dr. Duchon in effect was "gaming the system" by generating and falsifying his CE documentation. Mr. Fulkerson stated that it was unfortunate for Dr. Duchon that the CE audit system worked as it was supposed to and therefore he faces serious consequences. He then questioned where else Dr. Duchon might have short-cutted the system. Mr. Fulkerson stated Dr. Duchon refused to acknowledge the Board's authority in this regard.

Mr. Fulkerson stated that the Hearing Examiner's recommended order might seem severe in this matter. However, Mr. Fulkerson stated that the Board needs to recognize that it has taken five (5) sanctions in order to get Dr. Duchon's attention. He concluded by stating that Dr. Duchon has committed the highest level of fraud and should the Board decide not to adopt the Hearing Examiner's recommended order of revocation of Dr. Duchon's license to practice dentistry in Ohio, then they should impose a significant and severe suspension and penalty.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Motion by Dr. Kyger, second by Dr. Wallace, to move the Board into executive session pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) to deliberate and

consider the charges and report and recommendation filed in the matter of Stuart L. Duchon, D.D.S.

Roll call vote.

Motion carried unanimously.

OPEN SESSION

The Board resumed open session at 2:07 p.m.

Dr. Hills stated, "Let the record reflect that I was not present during executive session and did not participate in deliberations in this matter. Therefore, I will abstain from final vote"

DECISION IN THE MATTER OF STUART L. DUCHON, D.D.S.

Dr. Hills questioned, "Is there a motion concerning the Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation?"

Motion by Dr. Wright, second by Ms. Staley, to amend the Hearing Examiner's recommended Order as follows:

It is hereby Ordered:

- 1. The license of STUART L. DUCHON, D.D.S., to practice dentistry in the state of Ohio shall remain SUSPENDED and shall not be reinstated for a minimum of eighteen (18) months. DR. DUCHON shall immediately refer*

all his patients who may need treatment within that time to other practitioners.

- a. No one in the dental office may perform dentistry or dental hygiene duties or otherwise treat patients during the period of suspension.*
 - b. A receptionist may answer the phones with "Dr. Duchon's Office", or the name of the practice, for the sole purpose of answering questions, scheduling/rescheduling appointments, and making referrals.*
 - c. Dr. Duchon may not receive any income either from a legal or beneficial interest in the dental practice during the period of suspension.*
- 2. The BOARD shall not consider REINSTATEMENT of DR. DUCHON'S license to practice dentistry and all permits issued by the Board unless all of the following minimum requirements are met:*
- a. DR. DUCHON shall submit a written application for reinstatement, accompanied by appropriate fees. DR. DUCHON shall not make application until his suspension has been completed.*
 - b. DR. DUCHON shall provide acceptable documentation indicating successful completion of an eighty (80) hour continuing education program, approved in advance by the Board Secretary, a minimum of forty (40) hours of which shall be in dental ethics. These eight (80) hours shall be in addition to the forty (40) hours of continuing education necessary for renewal.*
- 3. Upon completion of suspension set forth in paragraph 1 of this Order, DR. DUCHON may resume the practice of dentistry in the state of Ohio, but his license shall be subject to the following PROBATIONARY terms, conditions and limitations for a period of no less than five (5) years:*
- a. DR. DUCHON shall submit quarterly declarations under penalty of Board discipline stating that he is in compliance with the probationary terms and conditions of this Order.*
 - b. DR. DUCHON shall take and pass the Board's jurisprudence examination at the Board office within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order.*
 - c. DR. DUCHON shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio.*
 - d. DR. DUCHON shall appear before the Board or its designee as requested by the Board.*

This ORDER shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing of this ORDER.

Discussion followed wherein Dr. McDonald stated that the revocation was too severe a sanction in this case, however, the actions taken by Dr. Duchon to deceive the Board are serious and warrant a significant penalty.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)

PETER G. WOLFRAM, D.D.S.

Ms. Davis introduced Dr. Peter Wolfram who was appearing before the Board after a year of license suspension and other events that have led to this subsequent appearance before the Board.

Ms. Davis stated that in March 2005 Dr. Wolfram entered Laurelwood Treatment facility after being arrested and admitting to a chemical dependency problem. She stated that Dr. Wolfram admitted to abusing crack cocaine for approximately 1-2 years previously and had also been diagnosed with bi-polar disease. She stated that Dr. Wolfram completed treatment, appeared before the Board for three (3) visits and was ultimately reinstated to twenty (20) hours per week in July 2006. Ms. Davis stated that during that time Dr. Wolfram had criminal charges pending against him.

Continuing on, Ms. Davis informed the Board that in September 2006, just two (2) weeks before his trial, Dr. Wolfram relapsed and the Board received a positive urine screen. She stated that his license was immediately suspended in October 2006 and shortly thereafter Dr. Wolfram was convicted of one (1) count of Corrupting Another With Drugs, a Felony of the Second Degree. Ms. Davis explained that Dr. Wolfram was sentenced to two (2) years in prison and while waiting to be transferred to his permanent facility, Dr. Wolfram inquired as to the different programming offered. Ms. Davis indicated that at that time, Dr. Wolfram applied for and received acceptance to reside at Pickaway Correctional Facility, due to the fact that they had the only drug program offered in the state through the Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections.

Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Wolfram was admitted into treatment, offered through the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services in March 2006 and was released from this program successfully in July 2006. She stated that Dr. Wolfram was immediately transferred to Community Assessment & Treatment Services, Inc. (CATS) as a requirement, to complete his treatment. Continuing on, Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Wolfram was released from CATS in October 2006 and was "officially" released from prison at that same time.

Regarding aftercare treatment, Ms. Davis reported that Dr. Wolfram contacted COMPASS and has been seen there once a week for individual chemical dependency counseling, he is seen once a month by his psychiatrist for his personality disorder, and has been deemed able to safely return to practice. She stated that in addition to the counseling, Dr. Wolfram also attends three (3) NA/AA and one (1) caduceus meeting weekly.

Ms. Davis informed the Board that Dr. Wolfram entered into another consent agreement in March 2007 which stipulates that he must have his forty (40) hours of

continuing education completed prior to reinstatement of his license. She stated that Dr. Wolfram has not been able to complete these hours in this past year because of his incarceration, but that he has obtained over twenty (20) hours and has “interactive” meetings scheduled in the next few months in order to be in compliance with the terms of his consent agreement. Concluding her summary, Ms. Davis stated that she has explained to Dr. Wolfram that all hours must be completed in addition to the forty (40) hours required for renewal by the end of 2007 before the Board will consider reinstatement of his license to practice dentistry.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Wolfram explained that he was feeling-nervous and that after twenty-one (21) months of sobriety, he feels like a new person. When asked what he has learned about himself, he informed the Board members that he feels the need for God in his life as he realized that there is no other place to turn. He stated that he now realizes that the most important thing he learned is that he needed to feel better about himself and accept who he is.

Further questioning by the Board allowed Dr. Wolfram to explain that he sees himself back practicing dentistry full-time within the next two (2) years. He stated that he has been keeping busy performing as a magician and taking care of finances by living at home with his parents’ support. When asked, Dr. Wolfram explained that he has an extensive network of support from his family, sponsor, other doctors, and dentists who have called to support him along the way. He stated that he has a pastor, which he did not have the last time. The Board members inquired as to how he will continue to support himself until he is reinstated, to which he responded that he is currently looking for employment, possibly something in sales.

Dr. McDonald informed Dr. Wolfram that the Board would not consider reinstatement since this was his first interview since his relapse. Dr. McDonald stated that the Board recognized that Dr. Wolfram received a shortened sentence due to drug rehabilitation program and as a direct result received his early release. He then asked Dr. Wolfram how he felt about the treatment he received in CATS, to which Dr. Wolfram explained he felt the rehabilitation was better than that which he received at Laurelwood Hospital previously.

Dr. McDonald then ended the interview by explaining to Dr. Wolfram that the Board would like to see him again in September for a follow-up interview to discuss his progress at that time.

Mr. Yonadi stated that there are currently twenty-two (22) licensees under suspension. He informed the Board members that no new cases have been referred to the Quality

Intervention Program (QUIP) since the last Board meeting and we have four (4) cases pending QUIP.

Mr. Yonadi informed the Board that one hundred and forty-five (145) cases have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretary and are recommended to be closed.

AUDIT

Ms. Reitz informed the Board members that personnel from the Office of State Auditor have completed their audit of the Dental Board and its administrative functions. She stated that she would be sharing the written report with the Board members once it is received in the Board office.

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF DENTAL EXAMINERS MEETING

Ms. Reitz stated that next meeting of the American Association of Dental Examiners would be in late September. She requested that any Board members intending to attend the meeting should let her know.

ANYTHING FOR THE GOOD OF THE BOARD

HOUSE BILL 188

Ms. Reitz stated that House Bill 188 was the reintroduced version of House Bill 518 from the previous year that the Board had voted to oppose. She reminded the Board members that the draft language of the bill allows for the dental hygienist to enter into a collaborative agreement with a dentist to provide services when the dentist is not present and prior to any examination by the dentist. Ms. Reitz then requested that the Board take a vote on their position regarding the current legislation.

Ms. Staley commented that the two (2) bills were not the same and that prior to any decision on the Board's position, the Board members should have the opportunity to review and discuss the language. She stated that the language of the bill allows for educational requirements to be met prior to any dental hygienist entering into a collaborative agreement with a dentist. Ms. Staley stated that dental hygiene education has changed over the past twenty (20) years and indicated that she would be happy to share copies of the "Accreditation Standards for Dental Hygiene Education Programs" from the American Dental Associations Commission on Dental Accreditation in order to assist them in understanding the value, scope and depth of that education. She stated that she was "speaking from the heart" when she informed the other Board members that the public needs this bill because no one else is providing these services. She stated

that she hopes at some time they can learn to trust in the education that dental hygienists receive.

Dr. McDonald recognized Keith Kerns of the Ohio Dental Association, who stated that the language in HB 188 was the same as the last amended version of HB 518. Dr. Wright then called the question.

Motion by Dr. McDonald, second by Dr. Wallace, that the Board position is to oppose the language in HB 188 as written.
