CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Vesoulis extended greetings to everyone and noting that there was a quorum present called the meeting to order at 1:18 p.m. He requested all members and guests sign the attendance roster.

ENFORCEMENT REPORT

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S) WITH PROPOSED CONSENT AGREEMENT(S)

NON-RENEWAL OF LICENSURE – DENTISTS

The Board interviewed four (4) dentists for non-renewal of licensure. Each individual was found to have been practicing dentistry since January 1, 2006, has applied for reinstatement, and agreed to the terms defined in their individual proposed consent agreements.

RICHARD E. GIFT, D.D.S.

Ms. Hockenberry explained to the Board that Dr. Gift's license to practice dentistry in the state of Ohio had been reinstated at the Board's April, 2006 meeting. She stated that Dr. Gift was here for interview today as part of the terms of his licensure reinstatement and consent agreement with the Board.

Dr. Gift informed the Board that at the last Board meeting it had been determined that he was not compliant with his continuing education requirements for reinstatement. He stated that since that time he has completed the deficient hours and is now in compliance. Dr. Gift commented that he found this incident highly embarrassing since in the past he had always taken sufficiently more than enough hours of continuing education, usually in big chunks. However, he stated, this time he had been unable to attend a couple of the larger meetings and before he realized it was too late because he had not paid attention. He stated that he had become aware of the deficiency due to the issue regarding non-renewal of his licensure.

JOHN O. SCHWAMBURGER, D.D.S.

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board members that Dr. Schwamburger had been scheduled for an interview at the previous Board meeting in April. However, she stated, it had been discovered prior to his interview that he had forged some of his continuing education documents. She stated that Dr. Schwamburger's proposed consent agreement is different than those previous for reinstatement for non-renewal in that it includes stipulations for a suspension of licensure for ninety (90) days and an additional eighty (80) hours of continuing education in ethics.

Dr. Schwamburger informed the Board that he had not received the mailing for renewal of licensure and had been informed by a phone call on April 18, 2006 that he had not renewed his license. He stated that he discontinued practicing dentistry that day and obtained the information to reinstate his license. Dr. Schwamburger stated that he did not have sufficient hours to reinstate his license at that time so he just "penciled in some" additional hours on his log, which he had not actually taken.

Dr. Wright inquired as to whether Dr. Schwamburger valued his license to practice dentistry in Ohio as much as he valued his license to drive. He then stated that Dr. Schwamburger must walk by his license certificate every day he practices and questioned how he could not notice that it had expired. Dr. Wright then asked how many of the minimum forty (40) hours of continuing education Dr. Schwamburger had forged.

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board members that thirty (30) of the minimum forty (40) hours of continuing education hours had been forged.

Ms. Leshar commented that it appeared as though Dr. Schwamburger did not feel a great deal of remorse for falsifying his continuing education documentation and she questioned how much he valued his license.

Dr. Schwamburger stated that he has had no prior problems with the Board, but recognizes that what he has done was totally wrong and is quite sorry about it. He stated that this all came about because his address had not been changed and reiterated that he has no prior actions with the Board.

Ms. Hockenberry explained to the members that this proposed consent agreement is similar to a consent agreement issued about a year ago wherein the cases were similar with regards to falsifying documentation in an attempt to obtain licensure.

LAW AND RULES REVIEW COMMITTEE REPORT

Dr. Vesoulis stated that the Law and Rules Review Committee had met earlier that morning to finalize the recommended changes to the rules regarding local anesthesia by the dental hygienist, expanded function dental auxiliary (EFDA), and dental assistant radiographer certification. He stated that the document before the Board compiled all the recommended changes and new rules in this regard.

Ms. Naber commented that original language in House Bill 143 included continuing education requirements for maintaining EFDA certification and she voiced her concerns that this language was apparently left out in the final enrolled version of the bill.

Dr. Vesoulis recognized Bernadette Green, R.D.H., Ph.D. who thanked the Board members for the opportunity to speak to them regarding the enrollment of Sub. H.B. 143 which included the registration of EFDA's. Ms. Green stated that EFDA's have been seeking licensure through the Ohio State Dental Board since 1974 and that this legislation is the first tiny step. She stated that regulation will assist in their efforts to track EFDA's and that the Ms. Naber's and the Board's concerns with regards to continuing education is encouraging for them to hear as they would hope that in the future EFDA's will be required to complete continuing education to maintain registration with the Board.

Motion by Dr. McDonald, second by Dr. Kyger, to initial file Ohio Administrative Code rule 4715-8-02, 4715-9-01, 4715-9-02, 4715-11-03, 4715-11-04, 4715-12-01, 4715-12-02, 4715-12-03, 4715-12-04, and 4715-12-05, as amended, and to initial file new rules 4715-11-04.1 and 4715-11-04.2 as presented.

Dr. Beckwith stated that the Policy Committee will be reviewing the Boards' Disciplinary Guidelines for possible revision prior to the next meeting. He state that her would be e-mailing his recommendations to the Board members for their review.

Dr. Hills attested that he had spent in excess of twenty (20) hours per week attending to Board business.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

LETTER TO GENERAL DENTISTS REGARDING NEW ADVERTISING RULES

Ms. Reitz stated that she had supplied a copy of a letter that was being sent to all licensed dentists in the state of Ohio who are not claiming specialty recognition. She stated that the Board is still aware of advertising issues such as phone book listings and signs. She stated that the Board is sending this letter in an attempt to be proactive in this regard and to clarify the purpose and intent of the advertising rules, particularly as they relate to general dentists.

STATEMENT OF THE OHIO DENTAL ASSOCIATION – SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 518

Ms. Reitz stated that a copy of the Ohio Dental Association's (ODA) position statement regarding Substitute House Bill 518 had been provided for Board member review.

Ms. Reitz also stated that she had used the Board's statement on Sub H.B. 518 during her testimony, however, the statement had not addressed an amendment to the bill that had been submitted at 4:00 p.m. one day previous to the bill being heard in committee. Ms. Reitz stated that she had attempted to explain that her testimony was with regards to the initially filed version. Additionally, she stated that during testimony it became clear that the legislators did not understand the roles of both the Board and the Ohio Dental Association.

Keith Kerns, Esq. of the ODA commented that the position statement speaks for itself and that even with the recent amendments the bill is still substantially the same. He reiterated the bulleted points of the position statement as follows:

- Allows unsupervised dental hygienists to "work with" and presumably supervise certified dental assistants; and
- Allows unsupervised dental hygienists to administer local anesthesia; and
- Nullifies the longstanding prohibitions against establishing practices devoted primarily to the provision of dental hygiene services; and
- Exempts dental hygienists that are practicing unsupervised under a "collaborative agreement" from critical patient safeguards.

Ms. Wise commented that she is upset with regards to this bill and that there is a fine line that the dental hygiene members of the Board must walk in their position on this bill. Ms. Reitz stated that if the Ohio Dental Hygienists' Association has a position statement with regards to this bill then they should submit it to the Board in order that they may share it with all the Board members. She stated that to date she has not received any written position from the ODHA. Ms. Reitz also noted that Board members first and foremost, and as Board members, individuals could not vocally take a position in opposition to what the Board's position is on matters such as this. Dr. Armstrong echoed his agreement with this statement.

Ms. Reitz upon confirmation from Mr. Kerns indicated that the legislators are out for summer session and therefore there would likely be no further activity on this bill until November.

HOUSE BILL 311

Concluding her report, Ms. Reitz stated that House Bill 311 regarding the placement of sealants by the certified dental assistant has passed both the House of Representatives and the Senate is now awaiting the Governor's signature. She stated that there has been no further activity on the bill regarding dental assistants removing orthodontic bands and brackets.

CORRESPONDENCE

Ms. Reitz stated that copies of an announcement by the Western Regional Examining Board (WREB) regarding California becoming their twelfth member state had been included for the Board members' review. She commented that WREB is the only one currently not in support of a national licensure examination.

ANYTHING FOR THE GOOD OF THE BOARD

REMINGER & REMINGER – LETTER FROM PAUL-MICHAEL LA FAYETTE

Ms. Reitz explained that she had distributed copies of a letter from Paul-Michael LaFayette, Esq., attorney for James D. Haldeman, D.D.S. She stated that Mr. LaFayette was requesting that the Board change its website with regards to reporting of disciplinary actions in that the information regarding Notices of Opportunity and the counts therein. She stated that the website accurately reflects the charges issued and the Board's decision in each case. She concluded by stating that the website accurately lists the counts that Dr. Haldeman was cited for in regards to any action taken and therefore the website would remain unchanged.

OHIO DENTAL WORKFORCE ROUNDTABLE

Ms. Reitz stated that copies of a letter from William D. Hayes, Ph.D. President of the Health Policy Institute of Ohio had been included in their notebooks for their review. Additionally, she stated that attached to the letter was the final Report of the Ohio Dental Workforce Roundtable. Ms. Reitz stated that within the report are twelve (12) recommendations focused on access to care.

Ms. Reitz stated that she had attended several presentations over the past year and that essentially they determined that there are no quick and easy resolutions to the access to care issue. She stated that of the twelve (12) recommendations, of note, was that it was recommended to expand the roles of dental professionals and to develop incentives that encourage students incoming from needy areas to return to those areas and provide services.

2006 BOARD MEETING SCHEDULE

Dr. Kyger reminded the Board members that a rescheduling of the November meeting date had been discussed at a previous meeting of the Board. She stated that they had also discussed changing the August Board meeting from Wednesday, August 23

to Thursday, August 24 to better coincide with the ODA's Annual Session. She stated that they left these issues pending and she wished to discuss them at this time due to a conflict in her schedule.

After a brief discussion and poll of the Board members it was determined that both meetings would remain as previously scheduled.

Dr. Kyger then suggested that the Board consider the 2007 Board meeting schedule at its next meeting in August.

ADJOURN

Dr. Vesoulis adjourned the meeting at 3:09 p.m.
