ENFORCEMENT REPORT

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)

LAWRENCE H. KAISER, III, D.D.S.

Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board members that this is Dr. Kaiser's second appearance before the Board. She stated that Dr. Kaiser had appeared before the Board at its April meeting two (2) hours late and intoxicated. She stated that GlenBeigh Hospital was contacted the day after the meeting in this regard and Dr. Kaiser was subsequently admitted back into treatment on April 28, 2006 wherein he admitted to drinking prior to his appearance before the Board.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Kaiser began by apologizing for his inappropriate behavior in April and in wasting the Board's time. He stated that he has been in alcohol rehabilitation/treatment and is now living in a ¾ house at GlenBeigh. Dr. Kaiser stated that he now recognizes and has come to terms with the fact that he cannot control his drinking, that he is powerless in his addiction. Dr. Kaiser informed the Board that he has an Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) sponsor and a home group helping

him to build his spirituality. He stated that he is now turning to dealing with his emotions and issues with his divorce.

When questioned as to whether Dr. Kaiser was taking any medication, he responded that he was taking hypertension and gastric reflux medications only. When asked when Dr. Kaiser anticipates moving back to living independently, he informed the members that he would like to as soon as possible. However, he stated that he would like to return to practice first and then determine his housing conditions since his practice will determine whether he will be living with his parents or with his brother. Dr. Kaiser informed the Board that he will not be returning to his own private practice since he has been ordered by the domestic court judge to liquidate his practice as terms of his divorce.

Board members questioned Dr. Kaiser about his practice. Dr. Kaiser informed the Board that his practice has been empty since February, 2006 pending his legal issues and order to liquidate his assets. He informed the members that the phones have been shut off, however, a colleague has been handling his emergency patients and he made sure the word was out regarding the practice closing.

Upon additional questioning by the Board in regards to dealing with stress, Dr. Kaiser explained that he deals with stress by working out, calling his sponsor, and calling his friends to help support him.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Board resumed open session at 2:22 p.m.

Dr. Vesoulis informed Dr. Kaiser that the Board would like to have him return for a subsequent interview at the January meeting.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S) WITH PROPOSED CONSENT AGREEMENT(S)

CONTINUING EDUCATION AUDIT - DENTAL HYGIENIST

Ms. Reitz informed the Board that the next five (5) interviewees were dental hygienists who had been audited for Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and continuing education requirements for the 2004-2005 renewal period. She then asked Ms. Hockenberry to further explain the CPR/CE audit process.

Ms. Hockenberry stated that upon completion of licensure renewal for dentists and dental hygienist for the 2006-2007 renewal period, there were approximately 1300 +/- dental hygienists whom it was determined were not compliant with their renewal requirements pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 4715.25. She stated that in this regard, all of the dental hygienists audited to date have been audited for cause. Those causes include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Audited for previous disciplinary action;
- A copy of their CPR indicating certification at the time of renewal had not been submitted with their renewal form;
- A copy of CPR certification taken through an unacceptable provider was attached to the licensee's renewal form;
- The licensee had submitted an incomplete renewal form;
- The log of continuing education documented questionable continuing education or no continuing education documented.

Ms. Hockenberry stated that beginning in March, letters of audit requested that the licensee submit copies of their CPR card indicating certification at the time of renewal in addition to copies of their CE experiences indicating compliance with renewal requirements. She informed the members that the audits were mailed via Certified U. S. Mail, Return Receipt Requested, and that each licensee was given thirty (30) days to comply with the Board's request. Ms. Hockenberry stated that the Board has been seeing more cases of dental hygienists either coming before the Board for an appearance as part of a consent agreement, or being automatically suspended, or being issued a notice of opportunity for hearing, all for failing to properly renew their license.

Continuing on, Ms. Hockenberry stated that it should be noted that none of the licensees that were determined to have not been in compliance with the renewal requirements were immediately suspended, rather, through the audit process, they were given the opportunity to provide documentation of compliance prior to any formal action being considered.

Concluding, Ms. Hockenberry stated that the interviews conducted today were as a result of non-compliance with the CPR/CE audit. She stated that the following five (5) licensees had indicated that they were currently certified in CPR through an acceptable provider at the time of renewal. Ms. Hockenberry informed the Board that through the course of the audit it was determined that they were not certified in CPR at the time of renewal and therefore constitutes fraud or deception in attempting to obtain a license. She stated that each of the licensees has chosen to enter into a consent agreement with the Board which includes a suspension and a personal interview with the Board in order to reinstate their license to practice dental hygiene.
