ATTENDANCE

CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Armstrong extended greetings to everyone and noting that there was a quorum present called the meeting to order at 1:12 p.m. He requested all members and guests sign the attendance roster.

INTRODUCTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Dr. Armstrong welcomed the Board's newest member, Dr. Chris Hanners of Piketon and introduced him to the Board members and attendees to the meeting. He then took a moment to introduce the rest of the Board. Dr. Armstrong introduced himself as the Board Vice-President, a general dentist from Troy. He then introduced the other Board members: Dr. Edward Hills, the Board Secretary, a general dentist from Cleveland, Dr. Ketki Desai, a general dentist from Columbus, Dr. Berta Howard, a general dentist from Hamilton, Dr. Larry Kaye, a periodontist from Akron, Dr. Billie Sue Kyger, a general dentist from Gallipolis, Dr. William Leffler, a general dentist from Massillon, Dr. Douglas Wallace, an oral and maxillofacial surgeon from Fairfield, Mr. Clifford Jones, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, Ms. Linda Staley, a dental hygienist from Lima, Ms. Ann Naber, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, and Mr. Chad Readler, an attorney from Columbus.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Motion by Dr. Howard, second by Mr. Readler, to move the Board into executive session pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(3) to confer with counsel on matters that are the subject of pending or imminent court action and pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(1) to discuss discipline of a licensee.

Dr. Armstrong invited Ms. Reitz, Mr. Yonadi, Ms. Bockbrader, and Ms. Adair to attend the executive session.

OPEN SESSION

The Board resumed open session at 1:48 p.m. Dr. Armstrong approved the agenda for the afternoon as presented with the notation that the Chair may modify the agenda due to timing constraints or extenuating circumstances.

REVIEW OF THE JULY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

The Board reviewed the minutes of the July 9, 2008 Board meeting.

Motion by Dr. Kyger, second by Ms. Staley, to approve the July 9, 2008 Board meeting minutes as presented.

Motion carried unanimously.

ENFORCEMENT REPORT

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)

ARIC A. KEUHNER, D.D.S.

Ms. Davis introduced Dr. Aric A. Kuehner and stated that he was appearing before the Board for his third interview after completing treatment at GlenBeigh for Nitrous Oxide abuse. She stated that Dr. Kuehner had been reinstated to practice with restrictions. Ms. Davis stated that in addition to his continued attendance to required weekly meetings, Dr. Kuehner has remained in compliance with the Board's additional stipulations of limited working hours per week and no availability of Nitrous Oxide-Oxygen in his operatory. She stated that Dr. Kuehner is appearing before the Board today to seek reinstatement to full-time practice.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Kuehner stated that it felt good to be back in practice. He reiterated that he had been attending his meetings as required and continues to prepare for the marathon he intends to run in October. He stated that his partners in the practice have been limiting his patients to two (2) per hour, occasionally more, but he stated that did not happen very often. Dr. Kuehner explained that the patient base for the practice consists of many Medicaid patients and therefore they overscheduled due to the increased risk of "no-shows". Additionally, he informed the

Board that his partners have limited him to supervising one (1) dental hygienist and this helps limit him in the number of patients and workload.

Concluding, Dr. Kuehner stated that he worked twelve (12) hour days for two (2) years and has no desire to return to that pace. However, he requested that the Board consider reinstating him to practice full-time up to forty (40) hours per week.

Motion by Dr. Kyger, second by Ms. Naber, to fully reinstate the license of Aric A. Kuehner, D.D.S. to practice dentistry in the State of Ohio up to forty (40) hours per week.

Discussion followed wherein Dr. Armstrong requested clarification regarding the motion to fully reinstate Dr. Kuehner's license and the previous limitations on Dr. Kuehner's use of Nitrous Oxide-Oxygen.

Motion by Dr. Kaye, second by Dr. Leffler, to amend the Board's previous motion to include the provision that Dr. Kuehner shall not administer Nitrous Oxide-Oxygen.

Motion carried unanimously.

Dr. Armstrong then called the question regarding Dr. Kyger's motion to fully reinstate the license of Dr. Kuehner to practice dentistry up to forty (40) hours per week without ability to administer Nitrous Oxide-Oxygen.

Motion carried unanimously.

SAMUEL S. KALUDY, D.D.S.

Ms. Davis introduced Samuel S. Kaludy, D.D.S. and stated that he was appearing before the Board for his first appearance. She stated that Dr. Kaludy has been charged with three (3) Counts of Deception to Obtain Dangerous Drugs, Felonies of the Fifth Degree, in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio. She stated that he is attempting to enter into Treatment In Lieu of Conviction, but at this time, it is unclear whether this will occur.

Ms. Davis stated that in speaking with the detective in the criminal case, he had notified her that Dr. Kaludy had been very cooperative and confessed. Ms. Davis said that the detective had explained that Dr. Kaludy admitted to abusing Loracet for approximately 7 years after admitting to knee and hip problems which led to this abuse. She continued, stating that Dr. Kaludy admitted to the detective that he was writing prescriptions to family, friends and even some staff members involved. She explained that they would get the prescriptions filled and return them to Dr. Kaludy. Ms. Davis stated that the detective informed her that two (2) of his hygienists and one (1) assistant

were involved, but were not charged criminally, even though they could have been. She concluded by stating that Dr. Kaludy put these employees in very dangerous situations.

TODD NEWKIRK, ESQ.

Todd Newkirk, Esq., attorney for Dr. Kaludy, spoke to the Board members on Dr. Kaludy's behalf. He stated that Dr. Kaludy had been charged with three (3) counts of possession/deception to obtain dangerous drugs and had signed a proposed consent agreement with the Board that would come before them later that afternoon. He informed the Board that Dr. Kaludy had completed the in-patient treatment on Monday of this week and was requesting the Board's consideration to reinstate his license at this time. Mr. Newkirk stated that this case was atypical and that there were a few circumstances that led to this non-standard personal appearance before the Board.

First, Mr. Newkirk stated that medical problems with Dr. Kaludy's hip and knee, which require surgery, led to his dependence and subsequent abuse of Loracet. He stated that once his deception to obtain drugs had been discovered Dr. Kaludy stopped working immediately on June 23rd, 2008 and admitted that he was addicted to Loracet. Secondly, Mr. Newkirk stated that Dr. Kaludy ultimately signed a Consent Agreement with the Board, to be considered today, and had an assessment completed at Cleveland Clinic, wherein twenty-eight (28) day inpatient treatment was recommended but not felt necessary. Mr. Newkirk stated that Dr. Kaludy completed it anyway, accepting the diagnosis of dependency with a good attitude even though Dr. Kaludy exhibited no symptoms of withdrawal. He stated that Dr. Kaludy was just released on September 15th with staff approval, after completing 28 days and has been sober and out of practice for the past three (3) months. He informed the board that all urine screens received while in treatment were negative and has just completed arrangements for two (2) Alcoholics Anonymous/Narcotics Anonymous (AA/NA) meetings per week combined with caduceus and aftercare. Lastly, Mr. Newkirk stated that what makes this case so different from the usual impairment interviews is that Dr. Kaludy has no intention of returning to full-time practice. He stated that Dr. Kaludy has a few employment options available to him, including practicing a twenty-four (24) hour three (3) day week.

SAMUEL S. KALUDY, D.D.S.

Mr. Newkirk then introduced Dr. Kaludy who stated that he was very sorry and very embarrassed about what happened to his self, his family and profession. He stated that he had not meant for it to get out of hand, but that once he realized what was happening he voluntarily took himself out of practice and turned himself into the authorities. He stated that he had been seeking independent counseling prior to the evaluation at Cleveland Clinic and his subsequent inpatient treatment. Dr. Kaludy stated that he realizes that he has a problem and that he will have it the rest of his life, but knows that he is committed to treatment of his dependency issues. He stated that he is willing to do

whatever is necessary to avoid a relapse. He stated that he has been providing biweekly urine screens on a voluntary basis in the hopes that he can soon return to serving the public. Dr. Kaludy stated that he has sold his practice and has entertained a discussion from a fellow classmate to open a practice with both of them practicing part-time.

Dr. Howard inquired as to whether Dr. Kaludy's underlying medical condition still existed, to which Dr. Kaludy explained that he was still having issues with his hip and knee but has made arrangements with his surgeon to have those issues taken care of whenever he is ready. Also, he indicated that his wife is now in charge of dispensing his medications.

Dr. Armstrong questioned Dr. Kaludy's push for reinstatement so soon after completing his inpatient treatment and expressed his concerns over the expediency. Dr. Kaludy stated that when he was first offered the consent agreement in July, 2008 he had accepted the terms initially wanting to proceed with the treatment to first understand the issues. He reminded the Board that he entered into the treatment at Cleveland Clinic voluntarily and that he was not under any court order to do so.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Motion by Dr. Wallace, second by Dr. Leffler, to move the Board into executive session pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) to deliberate and consider the matter of Samuel S. Kaludy, D.D.S.

OPEN SESSION

The Board resumed open session at 2:31 p.m.

Dr. Armstrong informed Dr. Kaludy that they would not be considering reinstatement of his license to practice dentistry at this time and that they would like for him to come back for a subsequent interview during the November meeting.

Jayne Smith, Licensure Coordinator, had prepared a report of the licenses issued since the August 2008 meeting, for Board member review.
