CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

BRUNER, RICHARD E., D.D.S. (30018638) – Cincinnati

Based on the doctor not meeting the terms of his previously signed consent agreement. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed December 15, 2005.

ROTH, PHILIP, D.D.S. (3001380) – Cleveland

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed December 8, 2005.

SLACK, CRAIG A., D.D.S. (30018548) – Columbus

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to meet standard of care. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed December 8, 2005.

FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS:

Dental license shall be subject to a probationary term of six (6) months. This is based on the Board finding Count 1 of the Notice of Opportunity not to be true, in which alleged the doctor's failure to comply with the infection control rules pertaining to proper sterilization of surfaces and Count 2 of the notice of opportunity to be true, in which alleged the doctor's failure to comply with the infection control rules pertaining to heat sterilization. Order sent December 8, 2005 and will become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing this Order. Respondent has fifteen (15) days from date of mailing to file an appeal.
