CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

DUNNING, DONALD C. (30011380) – Parma Heights

Dr. Dunning is currently suspended indefinitely effective immediately. Prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if Dr. Dunning is physically/mentally able to return to practice of dentistry. Upon reinstatement, Dr. Dunning shall be subject to probationary terms for five (5) years. Effective date February 4, 2004.

GROSSHANDLER, MARK H., (30014086) – Zanesville

Dr. Grosshandler shall not undertake any new cases of orthodontic treatment, involving past, present or future patients. Dr. Grosshandler shall refer all current patients whose orthodontic treatment will not be completed by May 31, 2004 to other practitioner(s) for orthodontic treatment. Effective May 31, 2004, Dr. Grosshandler shall permanently cease and desist from rendering orthodontic treatment. Dr. Grosshandler shall immediately and permanently cease and desist from providing any surgical periodontal treatment to patients. Dr. Grosshandler shall

submit documentation of completion of eighty (80) hours of continuing education in veneers, crown and bridge and biological width within three (3) months of the effective date of this consent agreement. Such hours shall be taken at an ADA accredited dental college and shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary. Dr. Grosshandler shall not undertake any new cases of endodontic treatment, involving past, present or future patients until he has submitted satisfactory documentation that he has successfully completed a minimum of twenty (20) hours of continuing education in endodontics. Such hours shall be at a dental college accredited by the ADA and shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary. After the Board Secretary has informed Dr. Grosshandler that he may resume providing endodontic treatment, his endodontic practice is limited to anterior teeth and/or single canal teeth only. Dr. Grosshandler's shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of one (1) year following notification that he may resume providing endodontic treatment on anterior teeth and/or single canal teeth only and shall submit documentation for each patient to whom he provided endodontic treatment during the preceding month. After complying with probationary terms for one (1) year, Dr Grosshandler may seek Board approval to perform endodontic treatment on posterior and/or multiple canal teeth, subject to completion of such additional continuing education, at an ADA accredited dental college, designated and pre-approved by the Board Secretary. Should Dr. Grosshandler successfully comply with the continuing education and be notified by the Board Secretary that he may resume providing endodontic treatment on posterior and/or multiple canal teeth, his license shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of one (1) year and shall submit documentation for each patient to whom he provided treatment during the preceding month. In addition to the probationary periods set forth above, he shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of two (2) years in which he must fully cooperate with the Board's inspection and evaluations of his dental office. Effective date is February 11, 2004.
