Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with standard of care. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed February 10, 2006.

FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS

HALDEMAN, JAMES D., D.D.S., (30016146) Columbus

Doctor's dental license is suspended for a period of ninety (90) days. Sixty (60) days of suspension is stayed. Doctor shall take twenty (20) hours of continuing education in ethics and submit a written request for reinstatement. Doctor shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years. Doctor shall (A) submit quarterly declarations under penalty of Board discipline stating that she is in compliance with the terms of this Order; (B) obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio, (C) provide sixty (60) hours of pro bono community dental service with documentation within six (6) months. Order shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing of the Order. The Order was mailed February 10, 2006.

Doctor's dental license shall be subject to a probationary term of two (2) years. Doctor shall (A) within 120 days of the effective date of this Order

successfully complete one or more courses (minimum of twelve (12) hours) dealing with appropriate methods of conducting TMJ examination and/or related courses. (B) submit quarterly declarations under penalty of Board discipline stating that he is in compliance with the terms of this Order; (C) upon request shall make any or all of his records available for inspection and review. (D) obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio, Order shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing of the Order. ROTH, PHILIP, D.D.S., (30013810) – CLEVELAND

Doctor's dental license shall be indefinitely suspended for a minimum of sixty (60) days. Doctor shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years. Doctor shall (A) obtain eight (8) hours of continuing education in infection control; (B) submit quarterly declarations under penalty of Board discipline stating that he is in compliance with the terms of this Order; (C) obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio; (D) upon request shall make any or all of his records available for inspection and review.
