CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

ALLEN, SHERMAN L. (30021490) – Michigan

Based on the doctor's alleged misrepresentation and conviction of a misdemeanor or felony. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed March 25, 2003.

BLAND, JOHN C. (30014822) – Warren

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to meet the standard of care. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed March 25, 2003.

CARRATOLA, THOMAS (30017926) – Streetsboro

Based on the doctor's failure to meet the standard of care. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed March 25, 2003.

SKIFFEY, JAMES J. (30013154) – Niles

CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

BEACHAM, WILLIAME. (30014044) – Lyndhurst

Doctor's license to practice dentistry is indefinitely suspended. Prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if physically/mentally able to return to practice of dentistry. Upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 5 years.

Agreement effective March 20, 2003

IVAN, RICHARD G. (30012686) – Hinckley

Doctor's license shall be suspended for thirty (30) days, effective April 1, 2003. In order to be reinstated, doctor shall meet following requirements: doctor shall make a written request to Board Secretary for reinstatement; doctor shall submit documentation indicating he is in compliance with infection control provisions and shall address each count in the Notice of Opportunity dated September 16, 2002 and how he has changed his procedures to correct the deficiencies identified therein. Doctor shall complete ten (10) hours of continuing education in dental infection control, pre-approved by the Board Secretary, and shall submit documentation within three (3) months of the effective date of the consent agreement. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam within thirty (30) days of the effective date. Upon reinstatement, doctor's license shall be subject to following probationary conditions for two (2) years: doctor shall fully cooperate with Board's inspections and evaluations of his dental office, doctor shall submit on a monthly basis documentation that the heat sterilizing devices in his office are tested for proper function on a weekly basis and doctor shall submit quarterly declarations stating that he is in compliance with the terms of the consent agreement. Doctor shall provide a minimum of three hundred and forty (340) hours of pro bono dental services to underserved populations, to be completed within one (1) year of the date of his reinstatement. Such pro bono shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary and shall be reported on a weekly basis

Agreement effective March 20, 2003.

MACK, LYNNE. (30015865) – Painesville

Doctor's license to practice dentistry is indefinitely suspended, effective immediately upon the date of signature (March 5, 2003). Prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if physically/mentally able to return to practice of dentistry. Upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 5 years.

Doctor's request for reinstatement granted by the Board, subject to probationary conditions established by January 2003 Consent Agreement.
