CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Armstrong extended greetings to everyone and noting that there was a quorum present called the meeting to order at 1:33 p.m.

INTRODUCTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Dr. Armstrong introduced himself as the Board President, a general dentist from Troy, Ohio. He then introduced the other Board members: Dr. Billie Sue Kyger, the Board Vice President, a general dentist from Gallipolis, Dr. Berta Howard, the Board Secretary, a general dentist from Hamilton, Dr. William Leffler, a general dentist from Massillon, Dr. Ed Hills, a general dentist from Cleveland, Dr. Ketki Desai, a general dentist from Columbus, Dr. Larry Kaye, a periodontist from Akron, Dr. Douglas Wallace, an oral and maxillofacial surgeon from Fairfield, Mr. Clifford Jones, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, Ms. Linda Staley, a dental hygienist from Lima, Ms. Ann Naber, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, Mr. Chad Readler, an attorney from Columbus, and Dr. Chris Hanners, a general dentist from Chillicothe.

OPEN SESSION

The Board resumed open session at 1:46 p.m. Dr. Armstrong had previously approved the agenda for the afternoon as presented with the notation that the Chair may modify the agenda due to timing constraints or extenuating circumstances.

REVIEW OF THE JANUARY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

The Board reviewed the minutes of the January 7, 2009 Board meeting.

Motion by Ms. Staley, second by Dr. Kyger, to approve the January 7, 2009 Board meeting minutes as presented.

Motion carried unanimously.

ENFORCEMENT REPORT

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)

MARK DEVINCENZO, D.D.S.

Ms. Davis introduced Mark Devincenzo, D.D.S. and reminded the Board that he was appearing before the Board for his second interview after reporting to Glenbeigh on October 20, 2008 for inpatient treatment for opioid dependence. She stated that Dr. Devincenzo completed the inpatient treatment and was released November 17, 2008.

Ms. Davis stated that since his previous appearance before the Board, Dr. Devincenzo had informed her that two days after the January, 2009 personal appearance, he had met with his attorney in order to try and rectify any criminal charges relevant to this matter. She stated that Dr. Devincenzo has informed her that the prosecuting attorney stated they are willing to consider the possibility of treatment in lieu of conviction as an option at this time. Ms. Davis informed the Board that, as of today, Dr. Devincenzo has not been charged criminally and has not entered into any treatment in lieu of conviction.

Concluding, Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Devincenzo is still attending aftercare at Bethesda Oak in Cincinnati. She stated that Dr. Devincenzo remains in compliance with the terms of his consent agreement and is attending all meetings as required, all urine screens have been negative and he has been compliant with Board investigators.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Devincenzo reiterated that he has continued with his aftercare, treatment and meetings. He said that he has recently completed Step

7 of his Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) steps with his sponsor, keeps busy around the house and remains positive about his recovery. When asked what else takes up his time, Dr. Devincenzo stated that he has watched a lot of repeat episodes of the television show "Law and Order" and spends time cleaning the garage and basement. He informed the Board that he and his attorney have been in contact with the County prosecutors, but have received no further information regarding any pending charges against him.

When questioned regarding completion of the 7th step in his AA program, Dr. Devincenzo explained that the 7th Step requires one to humbly ask a higher power to have character defects removed. He stated that the next step is to create a listing of people whom he may have damaged as a result of his addiction. When asked how he views the future, Dr. Devincenzo stated that he is hopeful and that he wishes to continue with this program, that he is very comfortable with it, and that it fits in well with him living his life.

Board members inquired about Dr. Devincenzo's future employment. Dr. Devincenzo stated that the company he works for has granted him family leave time, and that they are holding a position for him and awaiting any Board decision that will allow him back working as soon as possible. Discussion followed regarding the opportunity for Dr. Devincenzo to return to work on a part-time basis, wherein Dr. Devincenzo clarified that he felt that his employer would consider and comply with the Board's recommendation in that regard.

Motion by Dr. Wallace, second by Dr. Howard, to reinstate the license of Mark Devincenzo, D.D.S. to practice dentistry in the state of Ohio for up to twenty (20) hours per week and pursuant to the terms of his consent agreement with the Board.

Motion carried.

Dr. Armstrong informed Dr. Devincenzo that the Board would like for him to appear before the Board at its April meeting to update them on his recovery.

STEPHEN P. GILMORE, D.D.S.

Ms. Davis introduced Stephen P. Gilmore, D.D.S., who was appearing before the Board for a subsequent interview after appearing for before them in January, 2009. She stated that at the previous meeting there had been some confusion regarding Dr. Gilmore's aftercare meetings. She stated that since that time, Dr. Gilmore has been attending more than the required number of aftercare meetings and that his documentation of the meetings is now in order.

However, Ms. Davis indicated that Talbott Recovery Services recommends that Dr. Gilmore be permitted to return to work, however, they recommend that he should only return on a part-time basis because of his past issues and very high potential of relapse. She stated that she was requesting that the Board consider very carefully whether to allow him to return to practice part-time and then possibly asking him to appear again at the April, 2009 meeting for further consideration. She reminded the Board members that Dr. Gilmore has been out of practice for over a year and concurs with Talbott Recovery in their assessment of his return to practice.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Gilmore informed the Board that he is still going to a lot of meetings at noon and in the evenings, his caduceus and his aftercare. He stated that he is working with a new person regarding his sobriety, has returned to Talbott for a revisit for alumni wherein there are ten (10) sessions that you help current patients there. He stated that it had given him the opportunity to discuss his addiction with other dentists and pharmacists, and discuss stressors and to get some feedback. Dr. Gilmore stated that he has been keeping busy with regularly working out and going to a lot of Xavier basketball games. He stated that he has two (2) children that he has been spending time with, one at The Ohio State University and one who will be graduating from high school this spring, whom he has been assisting with college applications.

Dr. Kyger inquired as to what he has done with regards to continuing education (CE) and addressing the lapse of practice. Dr. Gilmore explained that he has been working on typodonts and performing preps but he has not attended a CE course since his last appearance. He stated that he has mainly completed self-study CE via journals, but has signed up for an endodontics course in Cincinnati in March. Dr. Kyger asked if Dr. Gilmore was concerned with any lack of skills due to the lapse of time from practicing. Dr. Gilmore indicated that he felt that after thirty (30) years in practice, he felt it refreshing that it has come back so easily but feels confident that his skills will still be there.

Dr. Kaye asked if Dr. Gilmore was currently in compliance with his CE for this biennium. Dr. Gilmore informed the Board that he has acquired more than the required amount of CE for renewal.

Motion by Dr. Kyger, second by Mr. Jones, to reinstate the license of Stephen P. Gilmore, D.D.S. to practice dentistry in the state of Ohio for up to twenty (20) hours per week and pursuant to the terms of his consent agreement with the Board.

Motion carried.

Dr. Armstrong informed Dr. Devincenzo that the Board would like for him to appear before the Board at its April meeting to update them on his recovery.

REVIEW OF CASES WHEREIN NOTICE(S) OF OPPORTUNITY WERE ISSUED AND NO HEARING WAS REQUESTED

Dr. Armstrong turned the meeting over to Dr. Hills to conduct the evidentiary reviews. Dr. Hills then stated for the record:

“This is an evidentiary review involving dentists and dental hygienists that failed to renew their licenses pursuant to Chapters 119. and 4715. of the Ohio Revised Code. The purpose of this proceeding is to give the Board information about these matters, in lieu of the Administrative Hearing that would have occurred if these licensees had requested a hearing. The Board’s minutes will serve as the official record of this proceeding.”

Dr. Hills asked if the State would like to present any additional information to support the charges outlined in the Notices of Immediate Suspension and Opportunity for Hearing.

Ms. Bockbrader said yes and began by stating that she was introducing an affidavit for the Board’s review and consideration. She stated that State’s Exhibit 1 is an affidavit from Jayne Smith, Licensure Coordinator, wherein she attests that the following listed licensees failed to renew their licenses to practice by January 1, 2008 and have not submitted valid renewal applications as of the date of her sworn affidavit. Ms. Bockbrader stated that in the affidavit, Ms. Smith attests that the Board office has not received any continuing education nor has the Board executive office received any written requests for hearings from the following licensees.

Ms. Bockbrader informed the Board that State’s Exhibit 2 is true and accurate copies of all the Notices of Opportunity for Hearing and signed and dated certified mail receipts indicating that each licensee was served with their respective Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in these matters.

 - b. *The LICENSEE shall submit documentation satisfactory to the Board that all continuing education requirements are current and up to date pursuant to RC 4715.141 (dentists) RC 4715.25 (dental hygienists).*
 - c. *The LICENSEE shall take sixteen (16) hours of continuing education in Ethics, approved in advance by the Board Secretary.*
 - d. *The LICENSEE shall take and pass the Jurisprudence, Ethics and Risk Management (JERM) Exam administered by the North East Regional Board of Dental Examiners, Inc.*
- (3) *Once reinstated, the LICENSEE shall automatically submit documentation acceptable to the Board of satisfactory completion of the requisite hours of Continuing Education necessary for renewal for the next two bienniums. ENFORCEMENT UPDATE

Mr. Yonadi informed the Board Investigator Assistant, Barb Palmucci, had performed sixty-two (62) infection control evaluations. Additionally, Mr. Yonadi stated that thirty-eight (38) cases have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretary and are recommended to be closed.

FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS

Ms. Reitz reminded the Board members that they should have all received their manila folders with their Financial Disclosure Statements. She stated that the Board has the expense statements for each of the members for those expenses that have been paid by the State of Ohio. She stated that they would need to acquire their North East Regional Board expenses and submit all the information to the Board executive office. She stated that the Board office would be submitting it along with the \$25 fee. Ms. Reitz indicated that Mr. Yonadi would be in charge of collecting their disclosure statements.

BUDGET

Ms. Reitz told the Board members that she had been informed late last Friday that she would be required to testify on Tuesday at 1:00 p.m. regarding the Boards budget. She stated that they subsequently called back at 5:00 p.m. to state that the meetings were cancelled for this week. Ms. Reitz continued by explaining that there had been some wide-spread language that the Boards are being requested to make cuts in their budget. She stated that it is very frustrating in that we only spend what we make and that we are not being asked to lower fees. She stated that any leftover monies are place into the 4K9 fund which is used for "emergency" purchases or unexpected

appropriations such as the new licensure system that all the regulatory boards were required to purchase into. Ms. Reitz explained that she was not too concerned with any requests to make cuts since the Board is in the current process of reorganizing personnel. However, she stated that there is still the hope that the Board will be able to make its intended move to the larger office space in the Riffe Tower. She stated that she would keep the Board apprised as to when she would be providing testimony.

PRESENTATIONS TO DENTAL SOCIETIES

Ms. Reitz stated that, with the Board's permission and support, she has provided her presentation on the Board and its operations to several of the local dental societies, including Summit, Sandusky, Akron, Lorain, Maumee Valley, Cleveland and Keely. She stated that she has not been contacted regarding providing the presentation to Columbus, Cincinnati, but she will be presenting to the Dayton Dental Hygiene group. She stated that she has received very positive feedback to the presentations. Concluding, she stated that she is considering follow-up letters to the Dental and Dental Hygiene groups in order to provide more of the information across the state.

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF DENTAL ADMINISTRATORS /AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF DENTAL EXAMINERS MEETING

Ms. Reitz informed the Board members that the American Association of Dental Administrators/American Association of Dental Examiners Mid-Year meeting will be held in April this year in addition to the ADEX meeting coming up.

GENERAL DISCUSSIONS

Ms. Reitz informed the Board members that she had approached the Board officers regarding a change to the May Board meeting from the 13th to the 27th. She stated that she felt this worked out well since there is no scheduled meeting in June this year.

Ms. Reitz updated the Board on the status of changes to staff since the last meeting. She stated that there have been some difficulties in reclassifying the job, that the work load is keeping staff a little stressed, but that the office is handling it well. She stated that the assistance from our temporary staffing and the prospect of a dental hygiene student from The Ohio State University Dental Hygiene Department will help with the upcoming workload.

ANYTHING FOR THE GOOD OF THE BOARD

NORTH EAST REGIONAL BOARD

Dr. Armstrong commented that the North East Regional Board (NERB) examinations were in full swing. He stated that the annual meeting for NERB is June 17-20 this year. He encouraged any of the Board members who wish to participate in the examination process to attend the meeting. He stated that in order to examine they must attend the annual meeting every year, regardless of whether they have attended in the past. Dr. Armstrong concluded by informing the members that this will be the last year that the meeting will be held in June. He stated that from now on the meetings will be held in January in Washington, D.C.

ADJOURN

Dr. Armstrong adjourned the meeting at 3:01 p.m. He stated that the next meeting would be on April 8, 2009.
