

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in January 2001.

1. CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS

BLOINK, William A. – Springfield, IL

Doctor applied for a dental license. He previously entered into two Consent Agreements with the State of Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, “providing for the imposition of disciplinary measures. . .” for one, allegedly having “prepare and presented treatment plans for extensive restorative work which was not necessary given the dental conditions present”, and the second, for allegedly having “failed to properly diagnose tooth decay in a patient.” The Board determined that these actions constitute failure to furnish satisfactory proof of good moral character as required by ORC Section 4715.10(A). Proposal to Deny License and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed January 22, 2001.

LAFOLLETTE, MARYANN M. - Bremen

Ms. LaFollette applied for a dental assistant radiographer license. Based on claims of having submitted an application and payment to the Board in October of 1998, submitting documents and cancelled check in November 2000, also claiming to have mailed a second application in June of 2000, when the actual date of receipt was October 13, 2000 and subsequent investigation of the check revealed it to have been made payable to, and negotiated by, Lancaster Utilities, the Board determined that she failed to meet the qualification of “good moral character” as required by ORC Section 4715.51.(A) and B(2). 2. FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS

BERLIN, Kathryn A. (51001143) - Toledo

Dental Assistant Radiographer license is revoked, based on the Board finding count 1 of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to be true, involving conviction of misdemeanor. Agreement effective January 31, 2001.

DiMICHAELANGELO, Laury J. (30) – Columbus

Doctor's license to practice dentistry is suspended for a period of 2 years, after suspension license shall be reinstated for the sole and limited purpose of providing pro bono/community service dental work to underserved populations for a minimum of 1200 hours during a 1 year period; before reinstatement doctor must complete 24 hours of CE, successfully complete a clinical examination of the proper diagnosis and treatment of occlusal caries and file reinstatement application, upon reinstatement dental license subject to probation terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 2 years. Based on Board finding Counts 1-20, 22, and 24-26, of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing true, involving permitting, standard of care and misrepresentation. Order sent January 22, 2001. Effective 30 days from date of mailing. ***Doctor has appealed and received a stay.***

KLINE, Curtis B. (30) – Columbus

Doctor's license to practice dentistry is suspended for a period of 1 year, after suspension license shall be reinstated for the sole and limited purpose of providing pro bono/community service dental work to underserved populations for a minimum of 1200 hours during a 1 year period; before reinstatement doctor must complete 24 hours of CE, successfully complete a clinical examination of the proper diagnosis and treatment of occlusal caries and file reinstatement application, upon reinstatement dental license subject to probation terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 2 years. Based on Board finding Counts 1-19, 21-22, and 24, of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing true, involving permitting, standard of care and misrepresentation. Order sent January 22, 2001. Effective 30 days from date of mailing. ***Doctor has appealed and received a stay.***

FLOWERS, Cleon A. – Gahanna

Doctor's application for licensure to practice in the state of Ohio is denied. Order effective immediately upon receipt. Order sent January 23, 2001.

3. CONSENT AGREEMENTS

BALL, John W. (30018007) - Shaker Heights

Dental license was suspended for two weeks, had served suspension and was temporarily reinstated by Board Secretary, subject to Board approval and payment of \$60.00. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam; complete 20 hours of continuing education, for next three bienniums shall submit documentation of continuing education credits obtained. Agreement effective January 18, 2001.

MACK, William E., Jr. (30018643) – Brookfield

Dental license was suspended for two weeks to be completed by January 18, 2001. Upon payment of \$60.00, license shall be reinstated on January 18, 2001; doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam; for next three bienniums shall submit documentation of continuing education credits obtained. Agreement effective January 18, 2001.

MIKULA, James F. (30012812) – Lakewood

Dental license suspended for not less than 14 days, effective January 28, 2001. For reinstatement doctor must make a written request to the Secretary of the Board for reinstatement, submit documentation indicating that he is in compliance with the infection control provisions; upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to probationary conditions for 1 year, shall submit quarterly declarations of compliance, shall complete 7 hours of continuing education in infection control within 3 months, shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam. Agreement effective January 18, 2001.

MOORE, Timothy H. (30017677) – Columbus

Dental license reinstated, subject to probationary conditions for 5 years. Agreement effective January 18, 2001.

PIERRON, Thomas (30012538) – Dayton

Dental license was suspended for two weeks, had served suspension and was temporarily reinstated by Board Secretary, subject to Board approval and payment of \$60.00. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam; shall complete 20 hours of continuing education in dental ethics, for next three bienniums shall submit documentation of continuing education credits obtained. Agreement effective January 18, 2001.

SCHERBAUER, Richard A. (30018040) – Mayfield Village

Dental license was suspended for two weeks, had served suspension and was temporarily reinstated by Board Secretary, subject to Board approval and payment of \$60.00. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam; shall complete 20 hours of continuing education in dental ethics, for next three bienniums shall submit documentation of continuing education credits obtained. Agreement effective January 18, 2001.

TURNER, Chester C. (30017086) – Forest Park

Dental license was suspended for two weeks, had served suspension and was temporarily reinstated by Board Secretary, subject to Board approval and payment of \$60.00. Agreement effective January 18, 2001.
