MINUTES

ATTENDANCE

The Ohio State Dental Board (Board) met in Room 1960, 19th Floor of The Vern Riffe Center for Government and the Arts, 77 South High Street, Columbus, Ohio on May 21, 2008, beginning at 12:45 p.m. Board members present were:

CALL TO ORDER

Dr. McDonald extended greetings to everyone and noting that there was a quorum present called the meeting to order at 1:17 p.m. He requested all members and guests sign the attendance roster.

INTRODUCTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Dr. McDonald took a moment to introduce the Board. He introduced himself as the Board President, a general dentist from Springboro. He then introduced the other Board members: Dr. Mark Armstrong, the Board Vice-President, a general dentist from Troy, Dr. Edward Hills, the Board Secretary, a general dentist from Cleveland, Dr. Berta Howard, a general dentist from Hamilton, Dr. Larry Kaye, a periodontist from Akron, Dr. Billie Sue Kyger, a general dentist from Gallipolis, Dr. William Leffler, a general dentist from Massillon Ohio, Dr. Douglas Wallace, an oral and maxillofacial surgeon from Fairfield, Mr. Clifford Jones, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, Ms. Linda Staley, a dental hygienist from Lima, Ms. Ann Naber, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, and Mr. Chad Readler, an attorney from Columbus.

REVIEW OF THE FEBRUARY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

The Board reviewed the minutes of the April 23, 2008 Board meeting.

Motion by Dr. Leffler, second by Dr. Kyger, to approve the April 23, 2008 Board meeting minutes as presented.

Motion carried unanimously.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Motion by Dr. Howard, second by Ms. Staley, to move the Board into executive session pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(3) to confer with counsel on matters that are the subject of pending or imminent court action.

Motion carried unanimously.

Dr. McDonald invited Ms. Reitz, Mr. Yonadi, Mr. Casey, Ms. Adair and Ms. Bockbrader to attend the executive session.

OPEN SESSION

The Board resumed open session. Dr. McDonald approved the agenda for the afternoon as presented with the notation that the Chair may modify the agenda due to timing constraints or extenuating circumstances.

ENFORCEMENT REPORT

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)

RICHARD G. SKOULA, D.D.S.

Gail Davis, Dental Board Enforcement Officer, introduced Dr. Richard Skoula. She informed the Board that this was Dr. Skoula's first interview with the Board subsequent to successfully completing treatment at Cleveland Clinic. Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Skoula had been arrested for a DUI on March 10th, 2008 after getting into a car accident on his way to work. She stated that subsequent to his arrest, Dr. Skoula admitted himself into Cleveland Clinic on March 11th for inpatient treatment. She informed the Board that he successfully completed treatment and was released in April, 2008 after completing 28 days.

Continuing on, Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Skoula has entered into an Aftercare agreement with Cleveland Clinic to attend Aftercare and submit weekly urine screens. She indicated that there had been some confusion with the Aftercare requirement through Cleveland Clinic. However, she stated that Dr. Skoula had been very compliant with the Board in an effort to remedy the situation.

Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Skoula has been compliant with Board requests to this date. She stated that he is attending his required Alcoholics Anonymous/Narcotics Anonymous (AA/NA) meetings.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Skoula first thanked the members for the opportunity to speak with them and then explained that he felt he was doing well. He stated that he felt that the excellent education the Cleveland Clinic has provided him with the knowledge to deal well with the situations that led to his abuse. He stated that stress from his personal and professional decisions caused anxiety issues and episodes of shaking. Dr. Skoula stated that he is trying to get this all under control with this new knowledge.

When asked if he had ever practiced dentistry while under the influence, Dr. Skoula indicated that he had not. Dr. Skoula stated that once he had been arrested for the DUI charge, he realized that he had a problem and therefore, he checked himself into the Cleveland Clinic for evaluation and subsequent treatment.

In answer to the Board members questions about what he does in his free time while not practicing, Dr. Skoula told the members that he spends his mornings in prayer and reading books. He stated that he has been exercising, concentrating on eating properly and had most recently been approached by the Cleveland Clinic to come back and speak with others in an effort to help them.

Dr. McDonald thanked Dr. Skoula and then explained that in these situations the Board does not reinstate licenses upon completion of the first interview. He informed Dr. Skoula that he would like him to come back for a subsequent interview with the Board at its next meeting in July.

JOSEPH A. JEZ, D.D.S.

Ms. Davis explained to the Board members that Dr. Jez was appearing before the Board for his first interview. She stated that a Board enforcement officer confronted Dr. Jez after the Board executive office had received anonymous information that Dr. Jez had been arrested for a DUI. Ms. Davis stated that in addition to his most recent arrest, it was discovered that Dr. Jez has a few other DUI arrests in his past.

Continuing on, Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Jez entered into a consent agreement upon meeting with the investigator after admitting he had a problem. She stated that he had previously received treatment in 2001 and abstained from alcohol for 6 years. Ms. Davis told the Board members that Dr. Jez had stated that he thought he could control his drinking and began drinking nightly and while on vacation until, once again, the abuse got out of control at the beginning of 2008.

Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Jez reported to Cleveland Clinic on March 19, 2008 and that he was discharged with staff approval on April 16, 2008. She indicated that Dr. Jez has entered into an aftercare contract for weekly meetings and random urine screens. Ms. Davis stated that, as with Dr. Skoula's aftercare contract, there has also been some confusion with Dr. Jez's meeting attendance at Cleveland Clinic. However, she stated that the issue is being discussed and taken care of with Board staff. Ms. Davis informed the Board that Dr. Jez had been attending his meetings, however there are 2 weeks where Dr. Jez did not attend the required three (3) AA/NA meetings. Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Jez has been informed that before he is allowed to appear before this Board again, he will need to show improvement with his meeting attendance.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Jez explained that some major life changes in his relationships, remodeling his home, and his practice had triggered his return to alcohol. He stated that he had turned to alcohol in an effort to self-medicate, however, he stated that the issues never got better. Dr. Jez informed the Board members that he had resigned from his practice, which was not well received by his partners, and had relocated

to Florida in an effort to correct his issues. Dr. Jez indicated that in addition to the abuse, he had a history with Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) and that he was most recently diagnosed with Bipolar Disorder on his first day in treatment. He informed the Board members that he felt that his issues were truly more mood problems than abuse problems. However, he stated that he knew he could not “get on top of this problem” and needed assistance to keep him from returning to alcohol. Dr. Jez stated that yoga coupled with the medications for his disorders and the help of his sponsor will help keep him from abusing alcohol in the future.

Dr. McDonald thanked Dr. Jez and explained that in this situation, similar to Dr. Skoula, the Board does not reinstate licenses upon completion of the first interview. He informed Dr. Jez that he would like him to come back for a subsequent interview with the Board at its next meeting in July.

Mr. Yonadi informed the Board that there were nine (9) cases pending hearings, of which all have been assigned for hearing. He stated that we have eight (8) cases under appeal and one (1) case pending the Board's determination. Mr. Yonadi stated that there are currently twenty-one (21) licensees under suspension and informed the Board members that we have three (3) cases active in QUIP.

Mr. Yonadi informed the Board that forty-nine (49) cases have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretary and are recommended to be closed.

Due to the requirement in Chapter 4715.03(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, that "The board shall not dismiss any complaint or terminate any investigation except by a majority vote of its members,..." Mr. Yonadi reviewed the cases to be closed with the Board.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

SUSPENDED AUDIT AND WARNING LETTERS

Ms. Reitz updated the Board members as to the status of the dental/dental hygiene renewal. She reminded them that letters of suspension and audit had been mailed to 690 licensees in February who had not renewed by January 31, 2008. Ms. Reitz stated

that as a result of those letters, the Board mandated 150 warning letters, which included the licensees' attendance to eight (8) or sixteen (16) hours of Board-approved continuing education in ethics, to preclude formal action.

Continuing on, Ms. Reitz stated that she had attended the first two (2) offerings of the Board-approved course; one in Cleveland with Dr. Donna Homenko and one in Columbus with Dr. Ken Jones. She stated that in both instances she had given a brief preliminary presentation to the attendees to explain the Board's position in this matter and to further clarify that this was not to be considered "formal action" by the Board. Ms. Reitz went on to describe the responses of the attendees.

TEETH WHITENING IN MALL KIOSKS

Ms. Reitz stated that in a follow up to the issue regarding teeth whitening by unlicensed individuals, the sister station to WBNS Channel 10 News had run a similar story involving the use of an undercover camera. She stated that their interview revealed that their employees were in error on the medicaments being used and that in one instance an employee used a light on a consumer. Ms. Reitz stated that the owner of the company had been contacted and they had informed her that particular employee had been terminated. Ms. Reitz stated that at this point the Board should proceed with continuing to gather information on this issue.

SECRETARY'S EXPENSE REPORT

Dr. Hills attested to the Board that he had spent in excess of twenty (20) hours per week attending to Board business.
