**CALL TO ORDER**

Dr. McDonald extended greetings to everyone and noting that there was a quorum present called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m. He requested all members and guests sign the attendance roster.

Dr. McDonald invited Ms. Reitz, Mr. Yonadi, and Mr. Casey, to attend the executive session.

## **OPEN SESSION**

The Board resumed open session at 1:30 p.m. Dr. McDonald approved the agenda for the afternoon as presented with the notation that the Chair may modify the agenda due to timing constraints or extenuating circumstances.

## **INTRODUCTION OF BOARD MEMBERS**

Dr. McDonald took a moment to introduce the Board. He introduced himself as the Board President, a general dentist from Springboro. He then introduced the other Board members: Dr. Edward Hills, the Board Secretary, a general dentist from Cleveland, Dr. Mark Armstrong, the Board Vice-President, a general dentist from Troy, Dr. Larry Kaye, a periodontist from Akron, Dr. Berta Howard, a general dentist from Hamilton, Mr. Chad Readler, an attorney and the Board's public member from Columbus, Dr. Billie Sue Kyger, a general dentist from Gallipolis, Dr. William Leffler, a general dentist from Massillon Ohio, Ms. Ann Naber, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, Ms. Linda Staley, a dental hygienist from Lima, Dr. Greg Wallace, an oral and maxillofacial surgeon from Fairfield, and Mr. Clifford Jones, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati.

## **REVIEW OF THE JULY BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

The Board reviewed the minutes of the July 11, 2007 Board meeting.

## **ENFORCEMENT REPORT**

### **PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)**

#### **PETER G. WOLFRAM, D.D.S.**

Ms. Davis informed the Board members that Dr. Wolfram was before them for this second interview subsequent to his relapse, one year suspension and completing treatment. She stated that Dr. Wolfram had appeared before the Board at its June 2007 meeting wherein they had invited him back for a subsequent interview.

Ms. Davis explained that Dr. Wolfram continues to show compliance with his Consent Agreement with the Board and will have two (2) years of sobriety in October. She stated that he continues to attend COMPASS on a weekly basis and is subject to random urine screens through that facility. She concluded by stating that Dr. Wolfram has completed his required forty (40) hours of continuing education and continues to remain in compliance with the Board's requests.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Wolfram explained that he has been keeping busy building countertops with a friend for his business. He stated that in his spare time he goes to a lot of movies. Dr. McDonald asked Dr. Wolfram if he was ready to return to practicing dentistry to which Dr. Wolfram expressed that he felt more than ready to return to dentistry. Dr. McDonald stated that Dr. Wolfram has remained sober for almost two (2) years and this is his second appearance before the Board and would entertain a motion to reinstate Dr. Wolfram's license to practice at this time.

*Motion by Dr. McDonald, second by Dr. Wallace, to reinstate the license of Dr. Wolfram to practice dentistry in the State of Ohio subject to the terms of his consent agreement with the Board.*

Motion carried.

**STEPHEN P. GILMORE, D.D.S.**

Ms. Davis informed the Board members that Dr. Gilmore is appearing before the Board after completing treatment at Talbott Recovery Campus in Atlanta, Georgia in May 2007. She stated that Dr. Gilmore had signed a Consent Agreement in July 2007 after the Dental Board had received information that Dr. Gilmore went into treatment.

Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Gilmore was admitted to Talbott Recovery (Talbott) after members of his Caduceus group completed an intervention. She stated that an intervention was warranted as Dr. Gilmore has been in treatment on two (2) previous occasions and relapsed almost immediately both times. Ms. Davis stated that during his assessment with Talbott, Dr. Gilmore admitted that he is a chronic relapsing alcoholic.

Continuing on, Ms. Davis informed the Board that Dr. Gilmore had completed treatment at Shepherd Hill in 2000 and was nearing six (6) years of sobriety when he relapsed and went back to Shepherd Hill at the end of 2006. She stated that Dr. Gilmore admitted that he was not ready to quit drinking when he went into treatment in 2006. Ms. Davis stated that Dr. Gilmore began drinking again shortly after his release in February, 2007. She stated that after an "intervention" in early May he began reaching out for support and help in his Caduceus group and he subsequently reported to Talbott Recovery.

Ms. Davis informed the Board that Dr. Gilmore spent the three (3) months in inpatient treatment after his admission to Talbott in May, 2007. She stated that Dr. Gilmore's physician reports that Dr. Gilmore feels ready to return to practice. However, she stated that in his Continuing Care Plan, the physician recommended that in order to prevent relapse, Dr. Gilmore should have a limited work schedule (32 hours or less per week).

Concluding, Ms. Davis informed the Board that Dr. Gilmore is attending all required meetings along with his aftercare at Bethesda Oak Hospital (Bethesda Oak). She stated that he has signed a contract with Ohio Physicians Health Program (OPHP) for his random urine screens, but due to financial constraints will probably switch to a monitoring program with Bethesda Oak.

Board members began by asking Dr. Gilmore why he felt that this last treatment would be successful whereas his other rehabilitation attempts were not. Dr. Gilmore stated that while at Talbott they helped him address his underlying issues, specifically grief over the death of his friend.

When questioned as to how Dr. Gilmore has spent this time away from dentistry, he stated that he spends his time going to aftercare and caduceus meetings, as well as playing tennis three (3) times a week with his son. He stated that he relies on his sponsors to help support him.

Dr. McDonald explained that the Board does not consider reinstatement of licenses to practice on the licensees first interview visit with the Board. He explained that he would like to see him appear again before the Board at its November meeting and hoped that he continues in his recovery efforts.

**DANIEL R. PUGSLEY, D.D.S.**

Ms. Davis informed the Board members that Dr. Pugsley is appearing before the Board due to license renewal issues. She informed the Board that Dr. Pugsley did not renew his dental license when it expired on December 31, 2005. She stated that he continued to practice dentistry until June 13, 2006, even though he had been advised by a Dental Board Enforcement Officer to cease practicing on May 1, 2006. Ms. Davis informed the Board members that Dr. Pugsley signed a Consent Agreement in late June, 2006 and was supposed to appear before the Board at its August, 2006 Board Meeting. However, she stated, Dr. Pugsley did not appear, nor did he offer any explanation as to why he did not appear before them at that time.

Continuing on, Ms. Davis stated that criminal charges were filed against Dr. Pugsley at the Beachwood, Ohio police department in March of 2007 after many attempts were made, without response, to reach Dr. Pugsley by phone and mail. She stated that the criminal charges against Dr. Pugsley were recently settled with Dr. Pugsley being placed into a diversion program that included probation and community service.

Concluding, Ms. Davis informed the Board members that Dr. Pugsley has signed a new proposed consent agreement that is to be reviewed later during the meeting and that he has completed all requirements in regards to the proposed consent agreement. She stated that Dr. Pugsley is meeting with the Board as a condition of this consent agreement.

Members of the Board questioned Dr. Pugsley regarding his license renewal issues. When Dr. Pugsley did not immediately respond, Dr. Hills reiterated that Dr. Pugsley's license had been automatically suspended in January 2006, was told by an investigator for the Board in May 2006 that he needed to cease and desist practicing. Dr. Hills then stated that Dr. Pugsley was subsequently found practicing by Enforcement Supervisor, Joe Yonadi, in June, 2006, signed a consent agreement with the Board wherein he was instructed to immediately cease practicing until such time as an application for reinstatement and interviews with the Board were completed.

Dr. Pugsley stated that he had not shown up at the scheduled Board meeting in August 2007. He stated that he had entered into a diversion program in February 2007 as a result of the criminal action against him.

When asked by the Board members regarding the blatant showing of disrespect for his dental license, Dr. Pugsley stated that was a good question and he could only attribute it to the confusion in his office as to whether or not his renewal application had been sent. He stated that there was evidence that the check had been written for his renewal but no evidence that the check had been cashed.

Dr. Pugsley stated that in May 2006 he had been contacted by the Board and informed that he had not renewed his license. He stated that he had submitted another check at that time along with copies of his continuing education documentation, only to be informed that the substance abuse continuing education course that he had completed was not acceptable due to the self-instruction format. Dr. Pugsley stated that he had then taken a board-approved substance abuse course.

When asked by the Board members as to why he did not show up for his scheduled interview with the Board, Dr. Pugsley indicated that it was stupidity on his part and when nothing became of it he then continued to work. He offered to the Board members that he is currently seeing a therapist and is on anti-depressants as an explanation.

When Dr. McDonald asked him which license he respected more, his license to practice dentistry or his drivers' license, Dr. Pugsley did not respond. Dr. McDonald then excused Dr. Pugsley by indicating that the Board was finished with their questions.

Dr. Howard informed the Board that the Education Committee had reviewed two (2) requests for waiver of the continuing education requirement based on unusual circumstance, emergency or special hardship and were recommending the following individuals to receive waivers/extensions:

Stuart Klassman, D.D.S. – Extension to obtain balance of continuing education requirement by December 31, 2009

***Motion by Dr. Wallace, second by Ms. Naber, to accept the Education Committees recommendations and approve all the above applications and requests.***

Motion carried.

## **LAW AND RULES REVIEW COMMITTEE REPORT**

Dr. McDonald informed the Board that the Law and Rules Review Committee had met earlier in the day to review recommended changes that had been submitted by the Education Committee for revision to the continuing education rules. He stated that the recommended changes include the elimination of the mandatory substance abuse and infection control requirement for dentists and elimination of the twenty-five percent (25%) directly interactive requirement. Dr. McDonald concluded by stating that a draft of the proposed changes would be prepared and submitted to the Board members for their review prior to the November Board meeting.

## **POLICY COMMITTEE REPORT**

Ms. Reitz informed the Board that the Policy Committee has been working on drafts of two (2) policies, one regarding the use of Restalyn and Botox by the dentist and one regarding the monitoring of nitrous oxide-oxygen by the dental hygienist. She stated that she had submitted the drafts via e-mail to the Board members for their consideration. Dr. McDonald tabled the discussions on the two (2) draft policies until November, since some of the members had not received the documents for review.

## **TREATMENT CENTER APPROVAL COMMITTEE REPORT**

Dr. Hills informed the Board that the Treatment Center Approval Committee had reviewed and recommends approval of The Woods at Parkside as an approved treatment provider. He stated that outpatient care complies with the Board's recommended twenty-eight (28) day in-patient treatment.

*Motion by Dr. Wallace, second by Ms. Naber, to approve The Woods at Parkside as an acceptable treatment provider for impaired licensees.*

Motion carried.

## **SCOPE OF PRACTICE COMMITTEE REPORT**

Dr. Hills informed the Board members that the Scope of Practice Committee had met earlier that morning to discuss several scope of practice issues mostly involving the practice of the dental hygienist. He stated that the Committee had determined that the dental hygienist may not perform teeth bleaching such as Lumi-Lite or Zoom without the dentist present and that the dental hygienist may not perform examinations to patients in assisted living/long-term care facilities.

Dr. Hills continued by stating that the committee had reviewed correspondence from a "spa consultant" regarding providing "spa-inspired services" to dental patients

specifically if the dental hygienist could apply products and massage faces, necks and shoulders of patients. He stated that while the Dental Practice Act does not specifically prohibit licensed dentists from offering these types of services in the dental practice, the massages should be provided by appropriately trained and licensed massage therapists.

Continuing on, Dr. Hills stated that one (1) final correspondence asked if a periodontist could perform general dentistry to uninsured, indigent patients in a volunteer setting and whether or not the same periodontist could perform a restoration upon request from a referring dentist in cases wherein the periodontist was already administering a local anesthetic for a periodontal procedure. Dr. Hills stated that the Dental Practice Act specifically precludes any specialist from performing general dentistry functions outside the scope of their specialty. He stated that the committee will be requesting more information regarding the administration of the local anesthetic prior to making a decision.

### **SECRETARY'S EXPENSE REPORT**

Dr. Hills informed the Board that he had spent in excess of twenty (20) hours per week attending to Board business.

*Motion by Dr. Kaye, second by Dr. Wallace, to approve the Secretary's expense report.*

Motion carried.

### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Ms. Reitz briefly informed the Board members that a copy of the American Board of Dental Examiners, Inc. 2006 Annual Report had been provided for their review. She stated that Enforcement Supervisor, Joe Yonadi, would be assuming the position of Assistant Director at the end of the month and that the executive office is currently in the process of hiring an Investigator Assistant.

Ms. Reitz then informed the Board members that by mid-October, a letter regarding renewal will be mailed out to the dentists and hygienists. She stated that licensees will be given the option to renew on-line for the first time and if they choose this option they will not be required to complete a continuing education log as in the past. However, she stated that the renewal letter will also instruct those licensees who prefer to renew via hard copy to contact the Board office to request a renewal be sent to them. Ms. Reitz stated that licensees who submit their renewal via mail will be required to submit the completed continuing education log in order to renew their license.

## ANYTHING FOR THE GOOD OF THE BOARD

### POSITION STATEMENT: INITIAL LICENSURE

Ms. Reitz then provided the members with a copy of a position statement, prepared by Dr. Wright, regarding initial licensure. She stated that the New York State model (a.k.a. "PGY1) is an additional year of training in lieu of competency examination after dental school. She stated that many of the yearlong programs are not provided by ADA-accredited dental schools, but rather via hospital programs. Ms. Reitz requested that the members review the information provided and provide feedback.

### DENTAL BOARD WEB SITE

Mr. Jones inquired about the links that are included on the Board's website. Motion made by Jones, seconded by Staley, that the Board's website include all links to all professional organizations. Discussion ensued whereby Ms. Reitz indicated that she was unaware that there were any links to associations on the web site. She explained that it was her understanding, at least at the time the website was created, that links were not allowed. She stated she would look into the situation to confirm whether this was permitted. If so, she said she would add all links, if not permitted, all links would be removed.

### FIRST RESPONDERS

Dr. McDonald informed the Board members that he had attended HAZMAT training in Warren County in order to be better prepared in the event of a mass disaster. Dr. Kyger stated that the ADA's Council on Dental Practice was now considering proposals regarding dentists as first responders. She stated that this issue is moving forward and receiving positive response.

Dr. McDonald indicated that they are taking "baby steps" in this regard and slowly bringing dentists into the fold on this issue.

### ADJOURN

Dr. McDonald adjourned the meeting at 2:56 p.m. He stated that the next meeting would be on November 7, 2007. He then invited the members to stay for the substance abuse presentation being provided by Dr. Richard Whitney of Shepherd Hill Hospital.
