CALL TO ORDER

Dr. McDonald extended greetings to everyone and noting that there was a quorum present called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m. He requested all members and guests sign the attendance roster.

Dr. McDonald invited Ms. Reitz, Mr. Yonadi, Mr. Casey, and Ms. Adair to attend the executive session.

OPEN SESSION

The Board resumed open session at 1:25 p.m. Dr. McDonald approved the agenda for the afternoon as presented with the notation that the Chair may modify the agenda due to timing constraints or extenuating circumstances.

REVIEW OF THE SEPTEMBER BOARD MEETING MINUTES

The Board reviewed the minutes of the September 12, 2007 Board meeting.

Motion by Dr. Wright, second by Dr. Kaye, to approve the May 16, 2007 Board meeting minutes as presented.

Mr. Jones questioned why his motion and vote was not included in the September minutes regarding the website links. Ms. Reitz indicated that she recalled no motion being passed with respect to that issue. Mr. Jones stated he made a motion that passed successfully. Ms. Reitz said she recalled the discussion, considered it an administrative

issue, and did not recall any motion being executed by the Board. She stated that regarding the issue, she immediately ascertained the necessary information from IT and learned that the links were permitted, and therefore links were added to the Board's website. Mr. Jones insisted that a motion passed in this regard. Discussion ensued.

Motion by Dr. Armstrong second by Dr. Wallace, to reconsider the approval of the that the September minutes.

Motion carried unanimously.

Subsequent to the Board meeting, the notes from the September meeting were reviewed. It was determined that a motion was made by Mr. Jones, seconded by Ms. Staley, regarding the website links, however, there was NO VOTE. The matter was discussed, and Ms. Reitz said she would research the issue and make the necessary additions to or deletions from the website.

INTRODUCTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Dr. McDonald took a moment to introduce the Board. He introduced himself as the Board President, a general dentist from Springboro. He then introduced the other Board members: Dr. Mark Armstrong, the Board Vice-President, a general dentist from Troy, Dr. Edward Hills, the Board Secretary, a general dentist from Cleveland, Dr. Berta Howard, a general dentist from Hamilton, Dr. Larry Kaye, a periodontist from Akron, Dr. Billie Sue Kyger, a general dentist from Gallipolis, Dr. William Leffler, a general dentist from Massillon Ohio, Dr. Douglas Wallace, an oral and maxillofacial surgeon from Fairfield, Dr. Franklin D. Wright, a general dentist from Cincinnati, Mr. Clifford Jones, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, Ms. Linda Staley, a dental hygienist from Lima, Ms. Ann Naber, a dental hygienist from Cincinnati, and Mr. Chad Readler, an attorney from Columbus.

ENFORCEMENT REPORT

PERSONAL APPEARANCE(S)

AMY G. ROBINSON, R.D.H.

Ms. Davis introduced Ms. Amy Robinson, who was appearing before the Board for an initial appearance after signing a consent agreement in September 2007.

Ms. Davis stated that on August 9, 2007 Enforcement Supervisor Joe Yonadi received a phone call from a local dentist. She stated that the dentist had received information from several pharmacies that Ms. Robinson had called in bogus prescriptions for

Vicodin, using his DEA number. Ms. Davis stated that Ms. Robinson had used her husband's name and she was picking them up. She stated that upon arrival, Ms. Robinson told Mr. Yonadi that she was calling the prescriptions in because her husband had terrible back problems and she was trying to "keep him supplied" until he had surgery. Ms. Davis reported that the local police department was then called and Ms. Robinson was arrested and criminally charged on a misdemeanor charge; however the charge was dismissed and her lawyer expects her to be indicted on a Felony charge of Deception to Obtain Dangerous Drugs. Ms. Davis stated that Ms. Robinson's lawyer indicated that he will then attempt to get her into the Treatment In Lieu Of Conviction program, as she has no prior criminal record.

Continuing on, Ms. Davis indicated that on a later date, Ms. Robinson finally took responsibility and admitted that she was in fact the person abusing Vicodin. She stated that Ms. Robinson had admitted herself into The Woods at Parkside on August 11, 2007 completed her 28 day inpatient treatment and was released from the program on September 8, 2007. Ms. Davis stated that Ms. Robinson immediately began her Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOP), which she completed on October 24, 2007. Ms. Davis stated that Ms. Robinson has agreed to complete Aftercare with The Woods at Parkside for one year, pursuant to her Consent Agreement and that she has made arrangements for random urine screens.

Upon questioning by the Board, Ms. Robinson explained that her addiction had been ongoing over a two (2) year period. She stated that originally her husband had a back problem for which he had been prescribed Vicodin. She stated that she had been taking his medication occasionally for migraines until her husband's prescription ran out. Ms. Robinson explained that she had been originally calling them in for herself in her own name but had started calling them in under her husband's name also without his or her employers' knowledge. She informed the Board members that she had never worked while under the influence of the Vicodin and had only been taking the medication between the hours of 5:00 and 11:00 p.m.

When asked if she knew that what she was doing was illegal, Ms. Robinson stated that unfortunately yes, she was aware and completely understood her actions. She stated that only occasionally did she consume alcohol and that her drug of choice was Vicodin.

Dr. McDonald then ended the interview by explaining to Ms. Robinson that the Board would like to see her again in December for a follow-up interview to discuss her progress at that time.

ENFORCEMENT UPDATE

INTRODUCATION OF NEW DENTAL BOARD INVESTIGATOR ASSISTANT

Mr. Yonadi began the enforcement update by introducing the Board's new Investigator Assistant, Barbara Palmucci, R.D.H. He stated that Ms. Palmucci's

background in dental hygiene will be beneficial in her primary job functions, including infection control inspections. The Board members welcomed Ms. Palmucci.

ENFORCEMENT UPDATE

Mr. Yonadi informed the Board that there were fourteen (14) cases pending hearings, of which all have been assigned for hearing. He stated that we now have eight (8) cases under appeal and four (4) cases pending the Hearing Officer's Report and Recommendation. Mr. Yonadi stated that there are currently eighteen (18) licensees under suspension. He informed the Board members that no new cases have been referred to the Quality Intervention Program (QUIP) since the last Board meeting and we have three (3) cases pending QUIP.

Mr. Yonadi informed the Board that sixty-five (65) cases have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretary and are recommended to be closed.

Due to the requirement in Chapter 4715.03(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, that "The board shall not dismiss any complaint or terminate any investigation except by a majority vote of its members,..." Mr. Yonadi reviewed the cases to be closed with the Board.

Dr. Armstrong informed the Board that the committee had met earlier that day and they have four (4) policies for the members review.

POLICY REGARDING THE USE OF RESTALYN, BOTOX, AND OTHER DERMA FILLERS BY LICENSED DENTISTS

Dr. Armstrong stated that the purpose of this policy is to clarify the Board's position regarding the use of Botox, and Restalyn and other Derma-Fillers, by licensed dentists in the state of Ohio. He requested the members to take a moment to review and consider this new policy.

Motion by Dr. Wright, second by Dr. Armstrong, to approve the "Policy Regarding the Use of Restalyn, Botox, and Other Derma Fillers by Licensed Dentists".

Motion carried unanimously.

POLICY REGARDING THE MONITORING OF NITROUS OXIDE BY QUALIFIED DENTAL HYGIENISTS

Dr. Armstrong stated that the purpose of this policy is to clarify the Board's position regarding the monitoring of nitrous oxide by qualified dental hygienists. He requested the members to take a moment to review and consider this new policy.

Motion carried unanimously.

POLICY REGARDING THE BOARD'S POSITION ON PGY1 FOR INITIAL LICENSURE IN THE STATE OF OHIO

Dr. Wright informed the members that they had received copies of a draft position statement regarding PGY1 at the previous Board meeting. He indicated that the committee members had discussed the merits of a position or white paper versus a Board policy and determined that drafting the language as a policy would carry more weight. Therefore, he stated that the committee was presenting the policy to the full Board.

Board members questioned whether this policy precluded the pathways to licensure that were put into place legislatively in the Ohio Revised Code. Dr. Armstrong stated that it is the Board's duty to protect the public and that any avenue to licensure that did not require an examination of skills was unacceptable to the Board.

POLICY REGARDING INITIAL LICENSURE IN THE STATE OF OHIO

Dr. Leffler suggested that the final policy, "Policy Regarding Initial Ohio Licensure in the State of Ohio" be amended rather than stipulating the Board's position on PGY1 in a policy. He recommended that the following language be added to the "Policy Regarding Initial Ohio Licensure in the State of Ohio":

"The Board supports the independent third party assessment of candidates for initial dental licensure and therefore does not support or accept Post Graduate Year (PGY1) training programs for initial licensure."

Motion by Dr. Wright, second by Dr. Armstrong, to approve the "Policy Regarding Initial Ohio Licensure in the State of Ohio" as amended.

Motion carried. Dr. Kaye abstained.

WAIVER COMMITTEE REPORT

Dr. McDonald informed the Board that the Waiver Committee had reviewed a Hepatitis B Waiver Request application and recommended approval of a one (1) year waiver for Gregory P. Haworth, D.D.S.

Dr. Hills informed the Board that he had spent in excess of twenty (20) hours per week attending to Board business.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF DENTAL ADMINISTRATORS

Ms. Reitz shared with the Board members her recent attendance at the American Association of Dental Administrators (AADA) meeting. She stated that some of the speaker topics included; personal versus professional integrity, and evaluating truthfulness. Ms. Reitz stated that during the Roundtable discussions the various administrators had spoken about issues going on in their particular state including, on-line renewals, oral surgery scope of practice, and testing issues.

Ms. Reitz informed the Board members that during the business meeting of the AADA, due to the President-Elect announcing her retirement, the organization. She stated that they had asked her to fill the position, which she accepted, and therefore, she was elected President and will be running the October 2008 Annual Meeting. She reminded the Board that she had previously held the position of President in 2002-03. She also stated that between the two (2) meetings, she gave three (3) presentations, including the one to the AADE floor.

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF DENTAL EXAMINERS MEETING

Ms. Reitz stated that she had Co-Chaired the American Association of Dental Examiners Attorney Roundtable Meeting in September. She stated that they had discussed on-going issues in other states, including oral surgery versus medicine issue and investigatory techniques and practices. Ms. Reitz commented that Kentucky has an undercover investigations unit for administrative agencies, which she found interesting.

ANYTHING FOR THE GOOD OF THE BOARD

NERB STEERING COMMITTEE

Dr. Armstrong indicated that he had attended the North East Regional Board Steering Committee meeting recently wherein he stated that he had received a lot of useful information. He stated that they had approved the new NERB Consultant Members and encouraged his fellow Board members to submit names of people they think should be considered, who would make good examiners.

Continuing on, Dr. Armstrong stated that a couple of bits of information were forthcoming from the Roundtable discussions. He stated that there is pending legislation in the state of Minnesota for an Expanded Function Dental Hygiene program which would allow for the trained dental hygienist to perform pulpotomies and extractions. Also, he stated that many of the NERB states require those dentists who

have not actively practiced for five (5) years or more must retake the NERB examination in order to re-license.

Dr. Armstrong continued by briefly mentioning that there is new technology in place that both the states of Michigan and Indiana currently use that allows practitioners to check over the Internet to see if patients are physician or prescription hopping.

One final comment Dr. Armstrong made was to commend Ms. Reitz on her development of the Board's "Disciplinary Guidelines". He stated that the past Board members and Ms. Reitz received accolades on the development of this document. He informed the Board members that there is only one (1) other state that has a document similar to this one and that we would probably be receiving many requests for copies in order that other states might develop their own guidelines in this regard.

2008 BOARD MEETING SCHEDULE

Ms. Reitz indicated that a 2008 calendar had been included in the Board meeting notebooks. She stated that at the previous meeting the Board members were asked to consider their schedules for 2008 and to be prepared to discuss next years Board meeting schedule at this meeting.

Board members discussed possible meeting dates for the year 2008 and decided on the following tentative schedule:

QUALITY INTERVENTION PROGRAM

Dr. Kaye stated that the Board is legislatively charged with the implementation and monitoring of the Quality Intervention Program (QUIP). He stated that the Board imposes actions on all other areas of licensure and enforcement excepting QUIP and he feels that a motion needs to be made with regards to actions of the QUIP program and panel in order that the Board remains responsible. He stated further that this motion was not a reflection of how QUIP is administered, or the personnel involved in its development.

Motion by Dr. Kaye, second by Dr. Kyger, that the Quality Intervention Program (QUIP) provide a report, "Review of Proposed Participatory Agreement for Quip", to be included in the Enforcement Report for Board member review, consideration and Board action.

Discussion followed wherein Dr. Kaye explained that he believed that like orders and consent agreements and notices, that the Board should be involved and vote on cases in the QUIP program. Ms. Reitz stated that was not possible due to confidentiality. She said QUIP was not like cases that result in notices of opportunity for hearing, or adjudication orders, or consent agreements, because QUIP is non-disciplinary. She stated that each month the Board is given the numbers regarding cases that the Board Secretary referred to QUIP. She said the licensee volunteers to then participate, and the entire process is confidential.

Ms. Reitz stated that she would request Dr. Awadalla, QUIP Coordinator, and Dr. Lightfoot as the previous QUIP Coordinator provide a presentation to the Board at its next meeting in order to clarify any questions the Board members may have with regards to the program. She stated that the QUIP rules are identical to those of the State Medical Board of Ohio (Medical Board) and that this is a non-disciplinary measure to address skills issues wherein a licensee would benefit from additional training in a particular skill or area. Ms. Reitz reiterated that the entire process is confidential unless or until the licensee does not appropriately complete the program. She stated the Ohio Dental Association had supported QUIP from the beginning. She stated that the Medical Board reports the activities of their intervention program but the reports are general in nature and include only numbers with reference to particular skills issues. Ms. Reitz reminded the Board members that this whole process is confidential in nature and that to provide information and permit involvement by Board members as was being requested would be in direct violation of the law and rules.

Dr. Hills further explained that QUIP allows the licensee the opportunity for a chance to remediate without penalty or action by the Board. He stated that the investigatory case is reviewed by a panel of several expert dentists throughout the state who have no connection to the Board or its members excepting that of QUIP panel. He stated that they provide a completely independent, unbiased evaluation of skills and make educational remediation recommendations. Dr. Hills concluded by stating that what Dr. Kaye was proposing toys with the confidentiality of the program and would jeopardize its usefulness and success.

Dr. McDonald then tabled the discussion and vote until after the next meeting wherein a QUIP presentation to the Board would be made.

ADJOURN

Dr. McDonald adjourned the meeting at 2:40 p.m. He stated that the next meeting would be on December 5, 2007. He then invited the members to stay for the infection control presentation being provided by Kathy Carson, Dental Board Enforcement Officer.
