Enforcement Update

Deputy Director Kochheiser began the Enforcement Update by informing the Board that there were seven (7) cases pending hearing. He stated that there were eleven (11) licensees and certificate holders under current suspension, thirty-five (35) licensees and certificate holders with older suspensions, and currently the Board has one-hundred and seventy-three (173) active cases. Deputy Director Kochheiser said that there was one (1) referral to QUIP. He informed the members that there were eighty-two (82) cases which have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretaries and are recommended to be closed with eight (8) warning letters issued. Deputy Director Kochheiser noted that there are thirty-seven (37) licensees currently on probation and ninety-one (91) cases that have been open for longer than 90 days as noted in the charts in the Board Notebook.

Due to the requirement in Chapter 4715.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code that, "A concurrence of a majority of the members of the board shall be required to "(6) Dismiss any complaint filed with the board[,]" Deputy Director Kochheiser provided a list of the cases to be closed by the Board.

Anesthesia/Conscious Sedation Permit Renewal Course(s)

Dr. Quereshy said that the Committee members also reviewed the Anesthesia Permit Renewal course submitted by the Sunbury Seminars, Inc. titled “Current Concepts in Office Anesthesia 2019”. The Committee recommended approval of the permit renewal course.

Dental Radiography Initial Training Course(s)

Dr. Quereshy informed the Board members that the Committee had reviewed an application for the Dental Assistant Radiographer Initial Training Course from MetroHealth System Department of Dental Medicine. He stated that MetroHealth is accredited through the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) and was now applying to provide their course titled “Dental Assistant Radiographer 7-Hour Initial Training”. He stated that the Committee recommended approval of the course.

Discussion Items

Dr. Quereshy stated that the Committee had discussed the pending revisions of continuing education rules, Ohio Administrative Code rules 4715-8-02, 4715-8-03, and 4718-8-04.

Dr. Quereshy stated that another topic discussed by the Committee was the possibility of trying to find or develop remedial education programs or providers to assist the Quality Intervention Program (QulP). The Committee recommended having the Research Committee look into some new educational centers or opportunities to find alternative remedial education courses for individuals requiring further education in clinical areas.

Finally, Dr. Quereshy stated that the Committee discussed the future of the eLicense program regarding continuing education. He stated that the hope is that there will be developments in the near future to streamline the continuing education documentation and licensure renewal process. Dr. Quereshy commented that he would like to come up with more goals for the Education Committee at the next strategic planning meeting for the Board.

Dr. Quereshy stated that the meeting adjourned at 11:45 a.m.

Law and Rules Review

President Subramanian stated that the Law & Rules Review Committee had not met that morning. However, he indicated that there was one matter needing to be addressed by the Board and requested Dr. Bean to explain.

Dr. Bean stated that Ohio Administrative Code rules 4715-5-05 and 4715-5-07, the Boards conscious sedation and general anesthesia rules were being amended to update and reflect the most recent versions of two (2) sets of guidelines of the American Dental Association House of Delegates; “Guidelines for the Use of Sedation and General Anesthesia by Dentists” and “Guidelines for Teaching Pain Control and Sedation to Dentists and Dental Students” as well as the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon’s “Office Anesthesia Evaluation

Manual.” She indicated that these two (2) rules had been previously voted on by the Board and initial filed as “no change” rules. However, amendments to these rules were required with the new editions of the manuals. Dr. Bean stated that the Board is continuing to draft the new anesthesia and sedation rules but must meet the five-year rule review requirement by the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR).

Motion by Dr. Bean, second by Dr. Subramanian, to initial file with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review, the Secretary of States Office, and the Office of Small Business the following rules:

- 4715-5-05 Use of general anesthesia and deep sedation.
- 4715-5-07 Use of conscious sedation.

Dr. Subramanian further explained that these two (2) rules had already been reviewed, approved and initial filed without changes. However, JCARR noted that reference materials cited in the rules were out of date and since the Board was in the process of revising the rules on general anesthesia and conscious sedation, the rules were withdrawn with the intent to file new rules on anesthesia and sedation. He stated that these minor changes will allow the Board to meet the five-year review deadline, and still continue to work on the new versions.

Motion carried unanimously.

Executive Updates

President’s Update

Moment of Silence in Memory of Former Board Employee Pamela Lively

President Subramanian informed everyone that the Board members had been notified by email from Director Kamdar earlier that week that Ms. Pamela Lively, the Board’s former Fiscal Officer who had retired in October, had passed away on December 8, 2019. He commented that Ms. Lively had always had a cheerful disposition, helped all of the Board members with their reimbursements and was always around to assist them. He then asked to observe a moment of silence in honor and respect of Ms. Lively.

Executive Summary of 2019

President Subramanian stated that he was honored to have previously been elected President of the Board. He thanked the Board members, past and present that he has had the privilege of working with. He thanked Executive Director Kamdar, for graciously lending his listening ears and imparting much wisdom. President Subramanian then thanked Deputy Director Kochheiser, Chief of Operations Zach Russell, and all the Board staff who had all worked unscheduled, inconvenient hours to accommodate his schedule in order to keep the Board agenda moving. He thanked everyone for working with him with the single-minded goal of protecting the citizens of the state. President Subramanian urged them all to work at the same trajectory to make the Ohio State Dental Board the board to be emulated in the future.

President Subramanian thanked everyone again and turned the meeting over to Director Kamdar for the Executive Director’s Update and Election of Officers.

Director Kamdar stated that he wished to convey, along with President Subramanian, that he and the staff were saddened by the news of Ms. Lively's passing. He said that Ms. Lively will be missed.

New Employee

Director Kamdar stated that the Board is very fortunate to be able to introduce the new Fiscal Officer, Shannon Stimer. He asked Ms. Stimer to come forward and stated that they would all get the opportunity to get to know Ms. Stimer because she would be processing their reimbursements from this point forward.

Ms. Stimer stated she had a lot to learn about the process and that she looks forward to meeting all of the Board members. Director Kamdar commented that Ms. Stimer comes from the private sector and welcomed her to the Board.

Adjourn

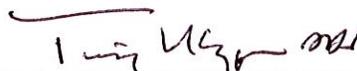
