## Call to Order

Kumar Subramanian, D.D.S. noted that there was a quorum present and called the meeting to order at approximately 1:32 p.m.

## Board Business

### Introductions

#### Board Members

President Subramanian had the board members introduce themselves.

### Approval of Agenda

President Subramanian asked if there was a motion to approve the agenda with the caveat to amend the agenda due to any extenuating circumstances.

## Review of Board Meeting Minutes

### May 8, 2019 Meeting

## Enforcement

### Report and Recommendations

#### In the Matter of Dermayne Huggins

President Subramanian turned the meeting over to Deputy Director Kochheiser to conduct the portion of the meeting related to review of Report and Recommendations. Mr. Kochheiser announced that the Board would now consider the Attorney Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation in the matter of Dermayne Huggins that was filed by Attorney Hearing Examiner Ronda Shamansky, Esq. on April 4, 2019.

Mr. Kochheiser asked for the record if each member of the Board had an opportunity to review the Report and Recommendation, transcript, exhibits, and objections in the matter of Dermayne Huggins that were made available on the Board Member Portal?

Mr. Kochheiser informed the Board that neither Mr. Huggins nor Katherine Bockbrader, Esq. had requested to present an oral argument under Revised Code 4715.039 and that they would proceed with the quasi-judicial deliberations.

Mr. Kochheiser indicated that only Board members would remain in the room for deliberations. He stated that they would be invited back in upon conclusion of the deliberations for announcement of a decision in this matter.

### Open Session

Mr. Kochheiser stated that the Board's minutes serve as the official record of the proceedings.

Mr. Kochheiser stated that Dr. Subramanian was the Secretary in this matter and that he was not present during and did not participate in the deliberations in this matter. Therefore, Dr. Subramanian will abstain from final vote.

### Decision in the Matter of Dermayne Huggins

*Motion by Dr. Zucker, second by Dr. Bauer, that in the matter of Dermayne Huggins:*

*The Board accepts all of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and the recommendation of the Hearing Examiner and the Board denies Dermayne Huggins application to practice in Ohio as a dental x-ray machine operator.*

Motion carried. Dr. Subramanian abstained.

The Board then resumed regular Board business.

## Enforcement Update

Deputy Director Kochheiser began the Enforcement Update by informing the Board that there were two (2) cases pending hearing with one scheduled in July and the other in the fall. He said the one case listed as pending Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation had been resolved earlier during the meeting. He informed the members that there were twelve (12) licensees and certificate holders under current suspension, thirty-five (35) licensees and certificate holders with older suspensions, and currently the Board has one-hundred and thirty-two (132) active cases. Deputy Director Kochheiser said that there was one (1) referral to QUIP and no licensees actively participating in QUIP. He informed the members that there were thirty (30) cases which have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretaries and are recommended to be closed with one (1) warning letter issued. Deputy Director Kochheiser noted that there are thirty-eight (38) licensees currently on probation. He indicated that there are eighty (80) cases that have been open for longer than 90 days as noted in the charts in the Board Notebook.

Due to the requirement in Chapter 4715.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code that, "A concurrence of a majority of the members of the board shall be required to . . . (6) Dismiss any complaint filed with the board[,]" Deputy Director Kochheiser provided a list of the cases to be closed by the Board.

Motion carried unanimously.

President Subramanian stated that the Board recently approved a change in the rules regarding licensure of graduates of international dental schools. He explained that because this rule clarifies the requirements for these dentists, it is unnecessary for those dentists who meet the requirements under the new rule, including completion of a 2-year accredited General Practice Residency (GPR) or Advanced Education in General Dentistry (AEGD) program and passage of all examinations, to wait until the next Board meeting before receiving their license. He further explained that many of these students could lose their visas upon graduation, so a delay in licensure can cause problems for their ability to obtain employment or even stay in the country.

President Subramanian indicated that the Board currently gives the Executive Director the authority to issue initial licenses to all dentists and dental hygienists if they meet the requirements for licensure. For this reason, he wished to request to give the Executive Director authority to approve the initial license applications of those dentists who have graduated from unaccredited dental colleges and who meet all of the requirements for licensure, just like dentists and dental hygienists who graduate from accredited dental schools in the United States or Canada. The Board would then ratify the licenses at the next Board meeting. He stated that this authority would not apply to international students that graduate from specialty programs.

*Motion by Dr. Bauer, second by Dr. Zucker, to delegate approval authority of international graduates that meet all of the current requirements of OAC 4715-18-01 to the Board Executive Director.*

Motion carried unanimously.

### General Anesthesia/Conscious Sedation Permit(s)

President Subramanian stated that the Board's Anesthesia Consultant, Gregory Ness, D.D.S., had reviewed the following individuals who have applied for General Anesthesia or Conscious Sedation Permits. Dr. Subramanian explained that the Board's rules do not provide for an additional facility evaluation to be performed, but the permit-holder is required to sign an affidavit to ensure that the appropriate armamentarium, personnel, etc. are maintained in the new facility pursuant to the guidelines in law and rules.

Dr. Quereshy expressed concern with the process and requested that this be revisited and reexamined when drafting the new rules for anesthesia and conscious sedation.

Motion carried unanimously.

President Subramanian stated that the Board's Licensing Manager had reviewed the applications and recommended that the following individuals receive Oral Health Access Supervision Permits.

Motion carried unanimously.

President Subramanian stated that the Board's Licensing Manager had reviewed and approved two (2) dental hygiene reinstatement applications and recommended that the Board ratify the following reinstatement applications.

## Committee Reports

### Education

Dr. Krob stated that the Education Committee meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. in room 1932 of the Vern Riffe Center. She said that in addition to herself, Committee members Dr. Ashok Das, Dr. Faisal Quereshy, and Dr. Zucker were present along with staff members, Mr. Russell and Ms. Franks. Dr. Krob noted that other Board members and guests were also in attendance.

### Minutes

Dr. Krob informed the members that the May 8, 2019 Committee Minutes were reviewed and accepted without modification via consensus of the committee members.

### Continuing Education Audit – Update

Dr. Krob stated that staff had provided an update on the proposed soft launch of the new process to evaluate licensee audits, how criteria are measured, and how delinquency and non-compliance will be handled. The end-goal is to have a practice that is perpetual and real-time.

### Review of Biennial Sponsor Application(s)

#### Initial

Dr. Krob then indicated that the Committee members had reviewed one (1) initial application for biennial sponsorship. The Committee recommended to approve the sponsor application for Shirck Orthodontics, Inc. This

approval is applicable for courses offered during the remainder of the biennium (which expires December 31, 2019), at which time the sponsor must renew sponsorship. This will be communicated to the applicant sponsors.

#### Renewal

Dr. Krob stated that in addition to the renewal applications, the Committee reviewed one (1) renewal applications for Biennial Sponsorship from Scott Silverstein, D.D.S., Periodontics and Implants. The committee approved the biennial sponsor renewal through December 31, 2019, at which time the sponsor must renew sponsorship under the current process. This will be communicated to the sponsor.

#### Discussion Items

The Committee again discussed Biennial Sponsor renewal applications specific to sponsors who renew applications and are requesting retroactive status. The conversation focused on proposed changes to the continuing education rules. With this in mind, the committee decided to grant retroactive status to the sponsor applicants to ensure that licensees who attended the courses provided prior to the submission of the renewal application would receive credit for these courses. This retroactive approval will include the May 2019 applications from:

- Dr. Greg Austria
- Dental Education Adventures, L.L.C.
- Vlad Shapiro, D.D.S. – Shapiro and Baker Periodontics and Dental Implants

*Motion by Dr. Quereshy, second by Dr. Zucker, to approve the applications for Biennial Sponsorship and the Education Committee Report as presented.*

Motion carried unanimously.

#### Law and Rules Review

President Subramanian stated that the Law & Rules Review Committee met that morning in Room 1948 in the Verne Riffe Center at 11:15 a.m. The meeting was attended by all members of the committee; Dr. Bean, Ms. Scaramucci, Ms. Intihar, Mr. Eric Richmond from the Ohio Dental Association (ODA), and Mr. Matt Whitehead representing the Ohio Dental Hygienists' Association (ODHA).

#### Minutes

President Subramanian informed the members that the Committee had reviewed and approved the minutes from the May 2019 meeting as presented with no changes.

#### Section 4715-8 Continuing Education

President Subramanian stated that the Committee decided after further review of the proposed continuing education rule changes that study clubs or the courses offered by study clubs would need to be accredited by an organization such as the American Dental Association Continuing Education Recognition Program (ADA CERP) and Academy of General Dentistry Program Approval for Continuing Education (AGD PACE), or approved by state or national dental associations like the American Dental Association (ADA), National Dental Association (NDA), American Dental Hygienists' Association (ADHA) or the local dental societies or the component societies. This would end the process of the Board acting as an accrediting body since the Board does not have the resources to perform due diligence in this area. He stated that language from the discussion would be drafted as presented and considered at the next Committee meeting.

## Draft Rules on Teledentistry

President Subramanian also reported that the Committee discussed the initial draft rules for the new teledentistry statutes. There was discussion regarding the educational requirements, including didactic and clinical hands-on training for both the placement of interim therapeutic restorations and the application of silver diamine fluoride. Members discussed the need for having complete informed consent from the parent prior to rendering services provided in schools and outreach programs. President Subramanian stated that the Committee decided to research existing informed consent forms and provide feedback within a couple of weeks so that the rules can be finalized and presented for discussion at the next meeting. He stated that they concluded their discussion and that there were no new topics submitted for further discussion and the meeting adjourned at 11:48 a.m.

*Motion by Dr. Bean, second by Dr. Kyger, to approve the Law and Rules Review Committee report as presented.*

Motion carried unanimously.

## Executive Updates

### President's Update

Reappointment – Kumar Subramanian, D.D.S.

President Subramanian took a moment to thank the administration and the support from the Board members on being reappointed to the Board. He stated that he was thankful for their support and that he hopes to continue with what is needed to move the Board forward.

### Appointment of Officers

President Subramanian took the opportunity to welcome Dr. Bean as the Acting Vice President and Dr. Kyger as the Acting Vice Secretary for the remainder of the year.

### Presentations to Former Board Members

*Constance Clark, R.D.H.*

President Subramanian introduced former Board member and Board President for the year 2016, Constance Clark, R.D.H. He stated that Ms. Clark did an outstanding job for eight years by mentoring the members of the Board. He then thanked Ms. Clark for everything she did as a Board member in representing the state of Ohio.

Ms. Clark stated that this was truly an honor and that those who know her, know that she is very passionate about dentistry, dental hygiene and the entire dental profession. She stated that she has shared about the day she got her license. She stated that she looked at her license and saw the names of the people who served on the Board and that these are people who go above and beyond to service this profession. Ms. Clark said to the Board member "Thank you for your service" and that she is glad they carry it forward and she wished them all the very best. Ms. Clark also thanked all the staff for all the support they gave her throughout the years.

He stated that with the addition of new Board members it had been suggested that they consider finalizing the Board meeting schedule for 2020 at their next meeting in July or August. He stated that a draft calendar with potential dates for Board meetings next year would be based on the dates for this year.

### Break

President Subramanian recessed the meeting for a ten (10) minute break.

## Presentations to Former Board Members

### Michael Ginder, D.D.S.

President Subramanian introduced Ann Cornwell Ginder, wife of former Board member Michael Ginder, and his son Will Ginder. He then stated:

“The State Dental Board, the dental community and the citizens of Ohio lost a wonderful man, Dr. Mike Ginder; a proud father, a devoted husband, and an ethical clinician. Mike passed away on August 16 of last year. Mike, to those who had the privilege of working with him and knowing him, was an amazing individual. He was passionate and completely dedicated to every task he took on. Mike used to be one of the best prepared Board members that I will ever have worked with on every issue. There are no words

to describe his compassion and the care that he provided to the community that he served. This was actually seen in the outpouring of grief in supporting messages received after his untimely passing.

Beyond all that, Mike was a wonderful human being who supported a number of worthy causes. He poured his heart and soul into everything he did. Again, words cannot describe the way he led his life and there is no way to express the respect that he commanded by his actions.

We would also like to add that the conference room at the Ohio State Dental Board has been named in Mike's honor and memory. It will henceforth be called the Mike Ginder Conference Room."

President Subramanian then requested Director Kamdar to present a plaque to Ann Cornwell Ginder.
