Call to Order

Dr. McDonald introduced himself as the Board President, a general dentist from Springboro, and extended greetings to everyone. Noting that there was a quorum present, Dr. McDonald called the meeting to order at approximately 1:06 p.m.

Introduction of Board Members

Dr. McDonald then introduced the rest of the Board members. He introduced Dr. William Leffler, a general dentist from Massillon, the Board's Vice President, , Dr. Marybeth Shaffer, the Board's Secretary, a general dentist from Leetonia, Dr. Ashok Das, the Board's Vice Secretary, a general dentist from Mason, Dr. Jacinto Beard, a general dentist from Gahanna, Dr. Chris Hanners, a general dentist from Chillicothe, Dr. Charles Smith, a general dentist from Tipp City, Dr. Douglas Wallace, an oral and maxillofacial surgeon from West Chester, and Ms. Constance Clark, a dental hygienist from Dublin, Ms. Susan Johnston, a dental hygienist

from Columbus, Ms. Anne Missig, a dental hygienist from Morrow and Ms. Ann Aquillo, the Board's Public member from Marysville. He stated that Dr. Lawrence Kaye, a periodontist from Akron, was not in attendance to the meeting.

The Board heard testimony and received evidence, State's Exhibits 1 through 12, from Lili C. Reitz, Esq., Executive Director of the Ohio State Dental Board. There were no additional witnesses or exhibits for the Board's consideration.

Upon conclusion of the testimony, the Board discussed any proposed changes to these rules as filed and any motions regarding potential changes to these rules. All the official transcripts from the hearing are maintained in the exhibits section of this journal.

Personal Appearance(s)

Michael Cobb, D.D.S.

Ms. Yehnert introduced Dr. Cobb to the Board and stated that he has work privileges of 32 hours at this time and is appearing before them today to request that full-time hours be granted. She recapped for the members that Dr. Cobb had entered treatment at Shepherd Hill in July 2013, was released in August 2013, and had his first appearance before them in September 2013. Ms. Yehnert summarized that Dr. Cobb had been granted up to 20 hours in work privileges in October 2013 and had his work hours increased again in December 2013 to 32 hours subsequent to interviews with the Board.

Continuing on, Ms. Yehnert explained that Dr. Cobb is in compliance with the terms of his consent agreement with the Board and has received positive feedback from Dr. Cobb's staff and associate, Dr. Lynch, several times over the past nine (9) months. Ms. Yehnert commented that it is the general consensus that Dr. Cobb is doing well in his recovery and appears to be very healthy and happy.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Cobb informed the members that he feels he is doing very well. He stated that he is still attending aftercare and caduceus meetings one (1) day per week and Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) meetings eight (8) meetings per week. He explained to the members that he is now nine (9) months into his sobriety, that he continues to work his steps with his sponsor, and he practices the steps in all his daily affairs. Dr. Cobb stated that he is now seeking to return to practice full-time due to the fact that his associate, Dr. Lynch would like to go back to part-time.

When questioned as to whether he felt that he would be able to maintain full-time work with his current schedule of meetings, Dr. Cobb explained that there were plenty of meetings to attend in his area if he found that his current meeting schedule conflicted with his practice. He informed the members that he feels he is doing well in handling his stress and that the biggest change he has made in his recovery has been to learn to talk to people.

Dr. McDonald requested that Dr. Cobb remain at the meeting as they would be discussing this matter during executive session.

Amy G. Robinson, R.D.H.

Ms. Yehnert introduced Amy Robinson, R.D.H. to the Board. She told the members that Ms. Robinson had entered into a consent agreement with the Board in September 2007 but was automatically suspended in May 2009 due to a violation of the consent agreement. Ms. Yehnert informed the Board that Ms. Robinson entered into another consent agreement in October 2009 and was subsequently automatically suspended

again in April 2013 due to a violation of that consent agreement. She stated that on March 25, 2013, Ms. Robinson notified the Board that she had a relapse and subsequently entered residential treatment at Total Treatment in Ocoee, Florida on March 29, 2013 and completed treatment in Florida on December 29, 2013. Ms. Yehnert said that on Ms. Robinson entered into a new consent agreement on July 13, 2013.

Continuing on, Ms. Yehnert informed the members that Ms. Robinson returned to Ohio in December 2013 and has been attending Alcoholics Anonymous/Narcotics Anonymous (AA/NA) meetings and is receiving counseling from Licensed Professional Counselor, Elaine Sturtz, through Peace United Methodist Ministry. Ms. Yehnert informed the Board that she has spoken with both Ms. Robinson and her counselor, Ms. Sturtz on several occasions over the past four (4) months. She stated that both have expressed that Ms. Robinson is working her program and doing well in her recovery.

Upon questioning by the Board, Ms. Robinson explained that on March 26th, 2014, she will celebrate one (1) year of sobriety. She stated that she was not currently working but she had been considering obtaining a non-dental related job until she could get her license back and at that time become more focused on obtaining a job in the dental field. Ms. Robinson informed the members that she attends several AA meetings per week, has a sponsor and friends who attend AA meetings, and that she meets with her counselor once per week. She concluded by stating that she is currently under a consent agreement with the Board and wishes them to consider reinstating her license at this time.

Dr. McDonald requested that Ms. Robinson remain at the meeting and informed her that they would be discussing this matter during executive session.

Timothy J. Backiewicz, D.D.S.

Ms. Yehnert introduced Dr. Timothy Backiewicz to the Board members. She stated that this was Dr. Backiewicz first appearance before them and he had recently completed residential treatment at The Woods at Parkside. Ms. Yehnert indicated that she and Ms. Reitz had met with Dr. Backiewicz and his legal counsel to discuss the terms of his consent agreement within the past month. She informed the members that Dr. Backiewicz had self-reported in January of this year and has not seen patients since entering treatment. Ms. Yehnert informed the Board that Dr. Backiewicz has a practice to return to and that he is looking forward to returning to the workforce. She indicated that Dr. Backiewicz has been informed that the Board does not consider reinstatement of licensure during the first interview after treatment has been completed.

Upon questioning by the Board, Dr. Backiewicz informed the Board that he had completed his 28 in-patient treatment January 30, 2014. He stated that he had self-reported due to difficulties he was having with his family and it had reached a point where he recognized that he needed help. He mentioned that he had attended other programs in the past but that none had apparently worked to help with his problem.

Dr. McDonald thanked Dr. Backiewicz for attending and reiterated that the Board does not reinstate a license to practice on the first interview following treatment. He then invited Dr. Backiewicz to appear for a subsequent interview at the April 2014 Board meeting.

She stated that Ms. Tkac has accepted the position of Investigator Assistant which was formerly held by Dental Board Enforcement Officer, Barb Yehnert. Ms. Reitz informed the members that Ms. Tkac will be in charge of performing infection control evaluations in dental offices around the state. She stated that Ms. Tkac has received training and attended some dental office visits with Dental Board Enforcement Officers; Kathy Carson, Barb Yehnert, and Jeremy Kimble. She stated that Ms. Tkac has been with the Dental Board for a few weeks and has performed her first infection control evaluations the previous day.

Dental Board Enforcement Officer, Kathy Carson began her report by informing the Board that there were four (4) cases pending hearings, all of which have been assigned. She indicated that there were currently forty-four (44) licensees under suspension and informed the Board members that there were four hundred and six (406) active cases. Ms. Carson said that there were seven (7) licensees currently considering QUIP, and six (6) licensees actively participating in QUIP. Ms. Carson completed her report by informing the members that there were one hundred and twenty-eight (128) cases which have been investigated and reviewed by the Board Secretaries and are recommended to be closed with twenty-seven (27) warning letters issued.

North Carolina State Board of Dental Examiners vs. Federal Trade Commission - Update

Ms. Reitz briefly updated the members on the North Carolina State Board of Dental Examiners (NC Board) case against the Federal Trade Commission (FTC). She stated that the case has now been accepted to the U.S. Supreme Court. She reminded the members that she had attended the oral arguments before the United States District Court of Appeals, Fourth Circuit in December 2012. She reminded the Board that the FTC had charged that the NC Board illegally conspired to restrict teeth whitening services to licensed dentists in North Carolina but that the nature of the case has changed in that the FTC now alleges that any board made up of a majority of licensees constitutes a conspiracy to restrain trade and is subject to prosecution under the nation's antitrust laws. She stated that the NC Board has argued that it is not a person, partnership, or corporation under Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, and therefore, the FTC has no jurisdiction over a state agency acting pursuant to a clear state statutory mandate. Ms. Reitz commented that the oral arguments back in 2012 were very interesting and that she has been invited to attend these hearings.

Dr. McDonald suggested that the Board should consider paying to have Ms. Reitz attend future oral arguments as this may directly affect the our Board. Ms. Reitz stated that she would keep the Board members apprised on future developments in this matter.

Anything for the Good of the Board

Former Board Member – Dominic A. Bitonte, D.D.S.

Dr. McDonald took a moment to mention that former Board member Dominic A. Bitonte, D.D.S. had recently passed away. He stated that Dr. Bitonte had served on the Board in the late 1980's. Several Board members shared their knowledge and memories of Dr. Bitonte, his accomplishments and philanthropy.

America's National Guard and Reserve Force Patriotic Employer Award Presentation



Age Analysis of Investigatory Cases


